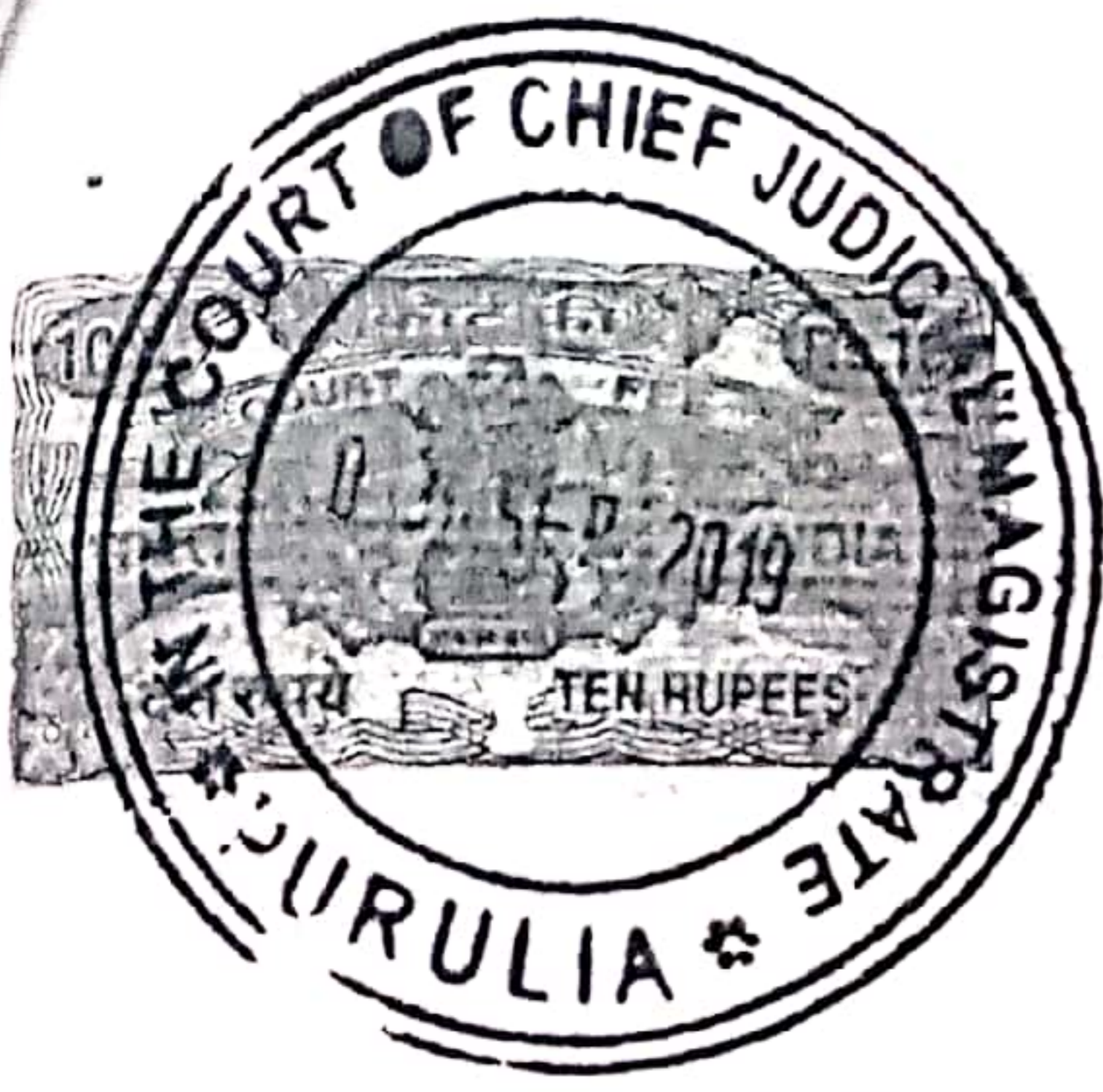

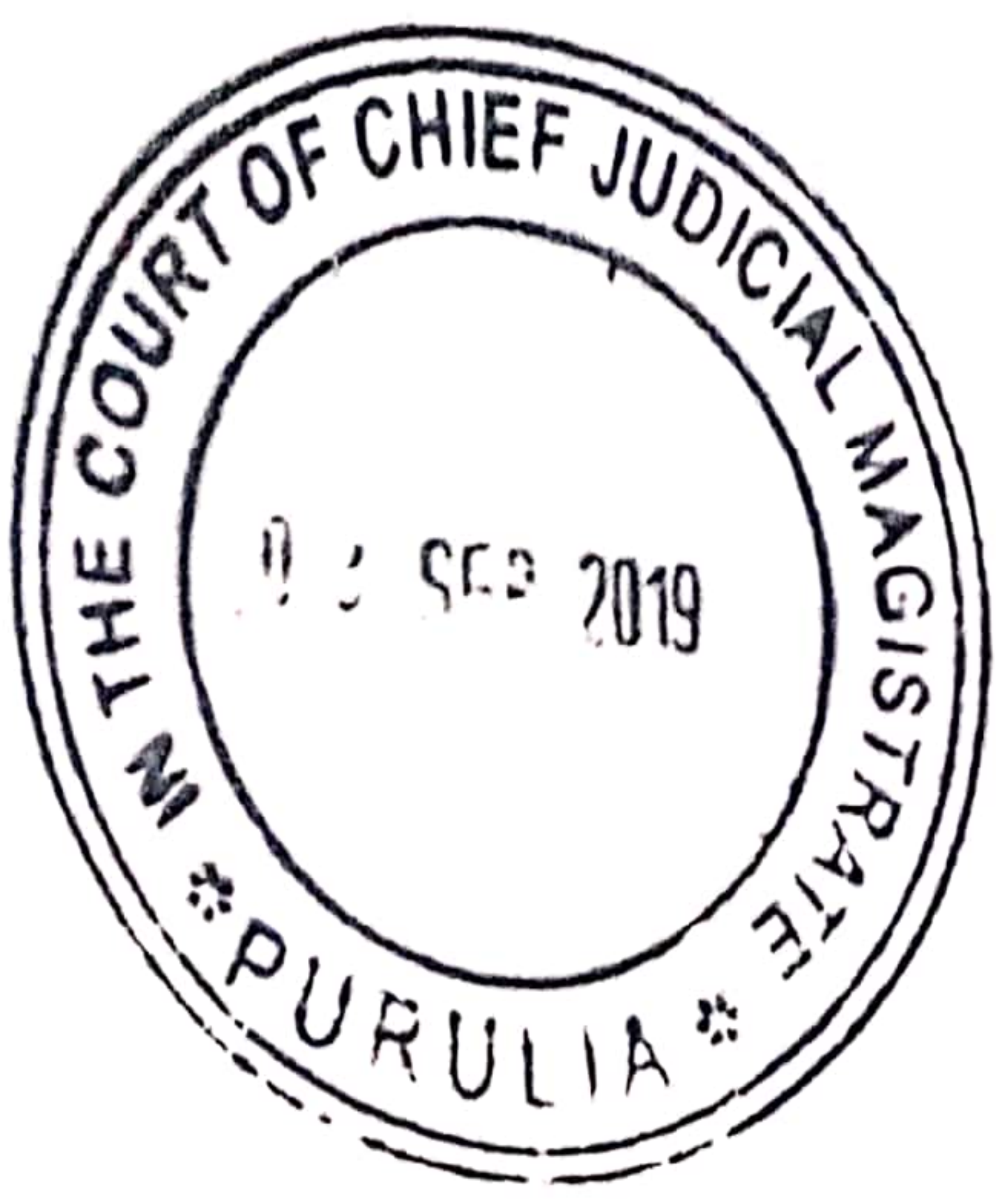

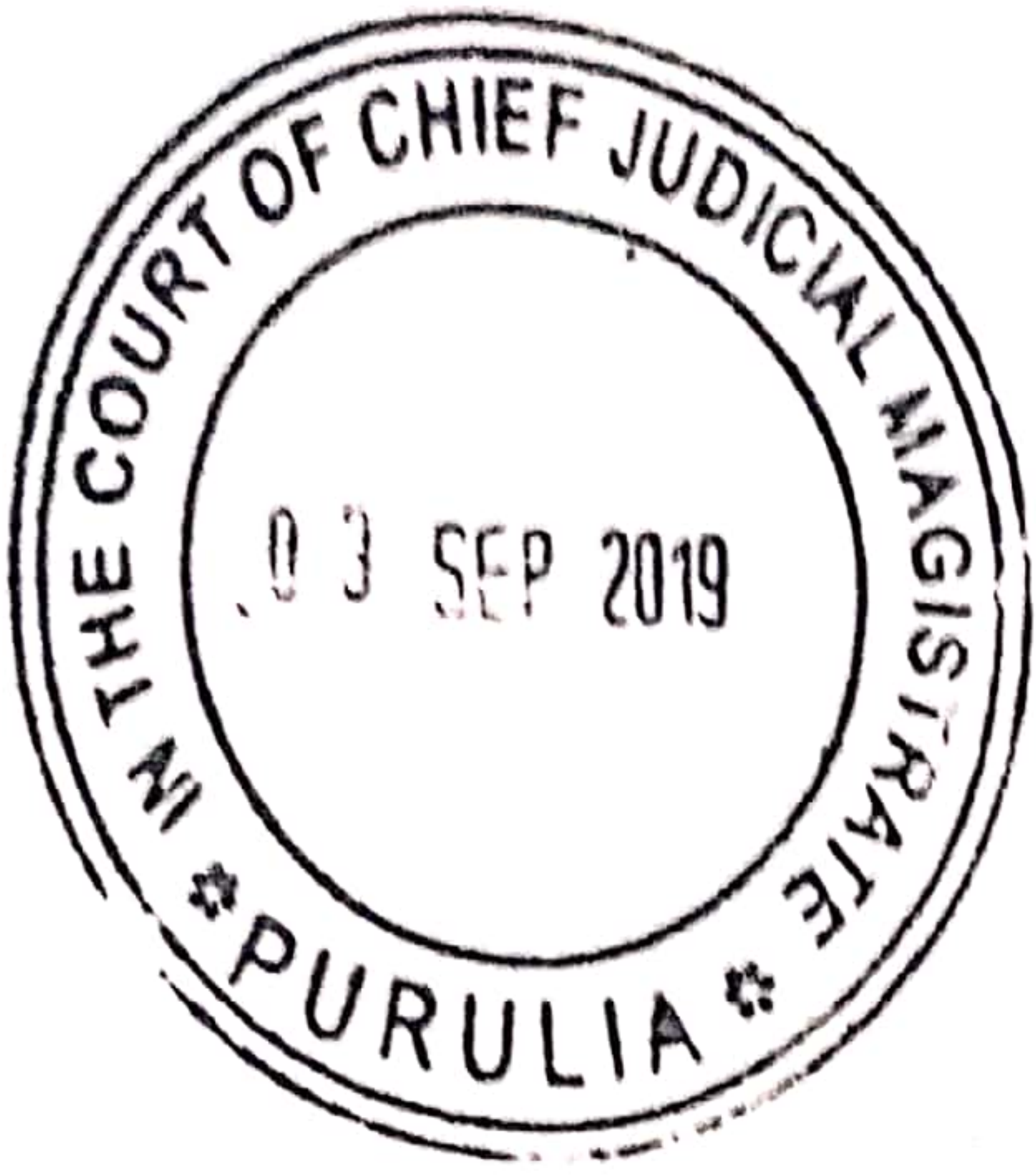

In the matter of an Application u/s 156 (3) Cr.P.C.

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

- 1) That the Complainant grown up various trees including a number of Papaya Trees and various vegetables like Ladies Finger, Spone Goard, Arum, Beans etc. which were almost ready for production in the land belonging to his share and situated adjacent to the back side of his residential house.
- 2) That a portion of the aforesaid land of the Complainant was initially purchased by his father along with his uncle Nishakar Mandal through a Registered Kobala Deed bearing no-1124 of the year 1971 measuring 16 decimal and the rest portion measuring area 17 decimal was purchased

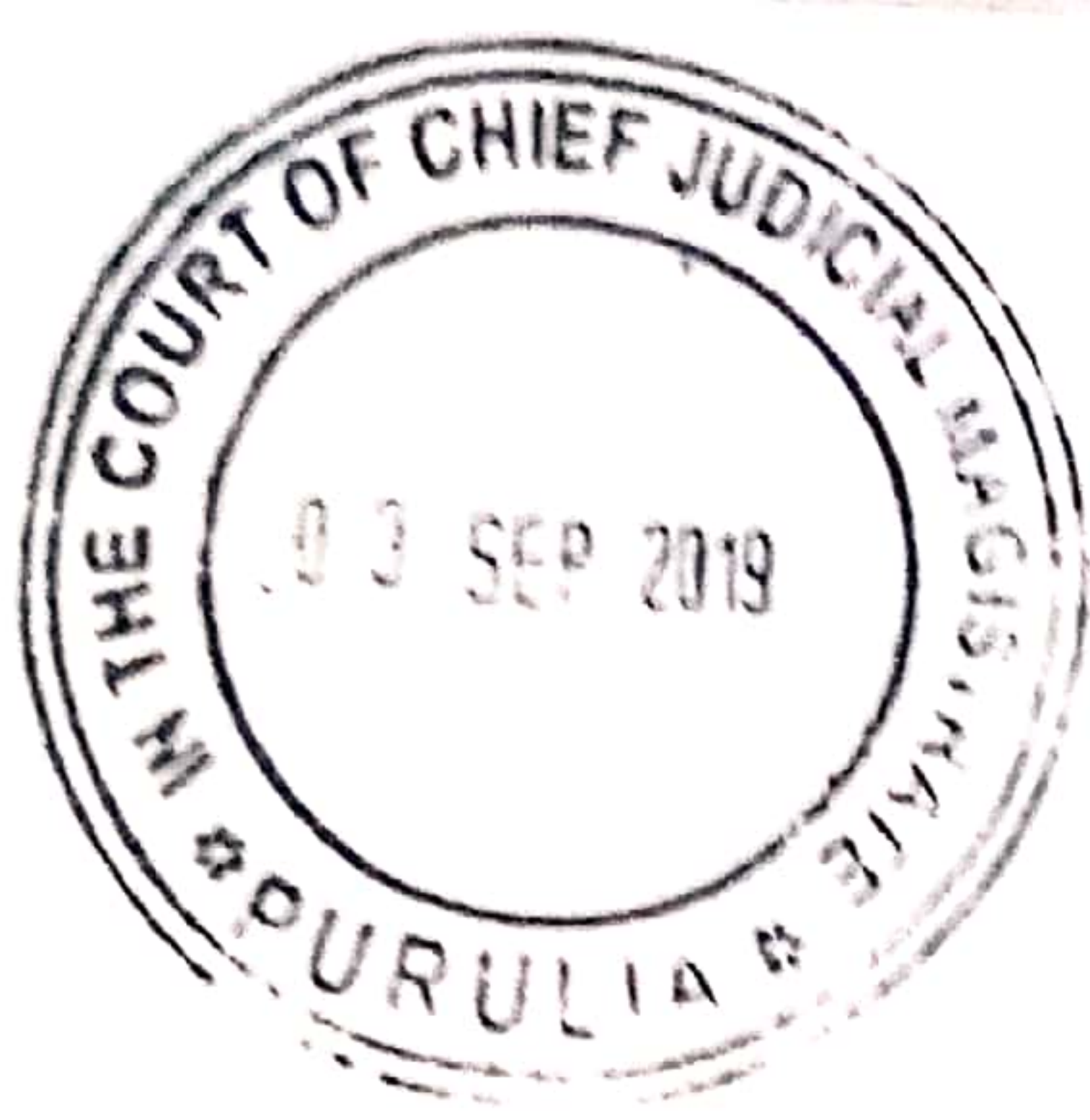

jointly by the Complainant, his brother Sri Sudhir Mandal and two sons of his uncle i.e. the Accused no-1 Chandi Charan Mandal and Sri Sukhdev Mandal through a Registered Kobala Deed no- 7554 of the year 1991 and subsequently the Complainant and his other co-sharers amicably partitioned the properties so purchased by the aforesaid two deeds amongst them and the Complainant thus came into specific and exclusive possession of the area measuring 5 kattha.

- 3) That on 12/08/2019 at about 5 p.m. the Accused Persons as mentioned above all on a sudden trespassed into the aforesaid land of the Complainant and that too being armed with axe and spade started abusing the Complainant and his family members in filthy languages and also started cutting down and uprooting the trees and vegetables plants grown up by the Complainant within the land in his share to which the Complainant and his wife tried to raise objection but they were badly threatened by the Accused Persons of dire consequences and of assault by the weapon they had in their possession at the relevant time. The Complainant, his wife and his other family members out of fear could not dare to go close to the Accused Persons but they were compelled to remain within their house.
- 4) That the very incident was witnessed by many neighbours of the Complainant including the witnesses no-3 to 7 as detailed in the list of witnesses as well as some passersby villagers namely the witness no- 8 Sri Munshur Majhi.
- 5) That the Accused Persons at that time hurriedly cut down the grown up trees and uprooted the vegetables plants and trees standing on the land of the Complainant as aforesaid and thereby caused a damage to the tune of Rs.10,000/- to the Complainant.
- 6) That after causing the damages as aforesaid and seeing the neighbours to come to the spot, the Accused Persons went back to their house.
- 7) That thereafter the Complainant had been to Sri Maheshwar Majhi, the Witness no-9 who was at the relevant time a member of Rokera-Bishpuria Gram Panchayet and brought him to the spot and showed him all the damages caused by the Accused Persons to his property.
- 8) That said member of the Gram Panchayet then advised the Complainant to inform the P.S. and accordingly on the next day the Complainant had been to Hura P.S. and lodged a Written Complaint there which was entered in the G.D. Book vide G.D.Entry no-594, dated-13/08/2019 and the police assured

the Complainant that they will take appropriate steps against the Accused Persons in due course.

- 9) That the Complainant trusted on the aforesaid assurance of the concerned Police Officer and came back to his home with the hope that the Police will soon take legal action against the Accused Persons. But all on a sudden on 21/08/2019 the Complainant was served with a notice u/s 107/116(e) Cr.P.C. from which it transpired that the proceeding was drawn against the Complainant as well.
- 10) That being astonished and aggrieved by the service of the very notice, the Complainant on 22/08/2019 informed the Superintendent of Police, Purulia the entire incident and requested him to take adequate steps against the miscreants but till date no step has been taken from the end of the police concerned and hence this Complaint.
- 11) That the Accused Persons have thus committed offences punishable u/s 427/447/506/120B I.P.C.
- 12) That the Complainant being a helpless and rustic villager is unable to arrange for producing the Witnesses in Court at his own cost. Moreover in the instant case various documents, incriminating weapons are to be seized which could not be possible without police help.

In the circumstances stated above, it is therefore prayed that Your Honour may be graciously pleased to send this Complaint to the O.C. of Hura P.S. with a direction to treat the same as FIR and to start the investigation in the matter and to prosecute the Accused Persons as per law.
