Sub: Prayer for starting a specific case under proper section of law.

Sir,

In producing herewith one seized dumper bearing registration No –JH 10AP/3279, Chassis No- MAT448117E3B03599 & Engine No- Not legible loaded with raw coal of 15 M.T. (approx) do hereby lodge a complaint to the effect that on (28/10/19) myself along with C/78 Utpal Sarkar and NVF/578 Niranjan Hembram all of Neturia PS were engaged in evening mobile duty vide Neturia PS GDE No- 1266 Dt. 28.10.19 & CC No- 2252/19 Dt. 28.10.19. In course of evening Mobile Duty, at about 19:05 hrs when we reached at Gobag More. I received an credible source information to the effect that one dumper bearing No- JH 05AQ/0813 loaded with illegal coal is standing beside road at Naragoria village. I immediately intimated to you over phone and acquainted you about the information and you directed me to work out the information. As per your direction myself along with force immediately started to move towards Naragoria village. Meanwhile at 20:25 hrs we noticed that a dumper was standing beside the road at Naragoria village. On searching we found the dumper bearing registration No- JH 05AQ/0813 was matched given by my source and the vehicle loaded with raw coal of 15 MT (approx). On proper searching we found that the No- JH 05AQ/0813 was written on a sticker and pasted over the number plate. When we removed the sticker we found that the registration No- JH 10AP/3279 is written on the number plate. We waited there for driver and registered owner but none turned up before us.

On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that the driver and registered owner of the said vehicle collected the said raw coal by fraudulent means, loaded the same in their vehicle from Jharkhand side through Simulia Ghat and was transporting the same in clandestine manner at Dubra side after changing the number of the vehicle.

So, there is reason to believe that the driver and registered owner of the said vehicle have collected the said coal either by theft or by any fraudulent means and trying to dispose the same coal to Dubra side knowing it to be stolen.

Accordingly I seized the said sticker and dumper bearing No – JH 10AP/3279 loaded with raw coal of 15 M.T. (approx) under proper seizure list duly signed by the Police witnesses in between 21:15 hrs to 21:30 hrs, since no public witness was found as it the P.O is in secluded place.

Under the above circumstances a specific case may kindly be started against the (1) driver of dumper bearing registration No – JH 10AP/3279 and (2) Registered owner of dumper bearing registration No – JH 10AP/3279 under proper section of law.
