

The humble petition U/S 156 (3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 on behalf of the petitioner above named;

Most respectfully begs to state:

- That the petitioner, Kiritibhushan Mahato son of Late Joychand Mahato,
 a permanent resident of Village Rangamati, P.S- Arsha, District-Purulia,
 is the real owner of the property R.S. Plot no. 3632 and 3633 situated in
 Mouza Rangamati, and accordingly within the jurisdiction of this Ld.
 Court.
- 2. That on 09/07/2019 at about 10.00a.m. the present petitioner went to his own land (described in above) for leveling the land by cutting earth.
- 3. That after some time the petitioner observed the accused persons namely, (i) Satyapada Mahato, (ii) Chittyaranjan Mahato and (iii) Nityaranjan Mahato, all are sons of Bhadari Mahato, residence of village Rangamati, and P.S. Arsha, District Purulia came in the aforesaid





land and started abusing in filthy language and said that the above mention land is there.

- 4. That the accused persons also threatened the petitioner to leave the place otherwise they would kill him.
- 5. That when the petitioner objected their such type of illegal act then one of the accused person namely, Satyapada Mahato hit the petitioner by blunt side of the an axe on the leg of the petitioner the petitioner fall down on the earth and also hit on the head of the petitioner with axe with an intention to kill him and the petitioner sustained various injuries.
- 6. That thereafter the accused persons are fled away from the place. When the family members of petitioner heard the incident they came to the place of occurrence and taking the petitioner went to Arsha P.S. and next for treatment went to Purulia Sadar Hospital.
- 7. That due to treatment of the petitioner in the Sadar Hospital Purulia for two days the petitioner could not inform the matter before Arsha P.S.
- 8. That thereafter the petitioner went to Arsha P.S on 11/07/2019 and submit a written complaint against the accused persons namely, (i) Satyapada Mahato, (ii) Chittyaranjan Mahato and (iii) Nityaranjan

Mahato, but the police refused to take any action against the accused persons.

- 9. That the matter was reported to Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 14/11/2019, but police yet did not start any case against the accused person.
- 10. That being rejected, your petitioner intends to file this instant application.
- 11. That this case requires through police probe including collection of medical records, examination of witnesses etc.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to direct the police of Arsha P.S to treat this petition as a F. I. R. and to cause investigation in respect of the alleged incident.
