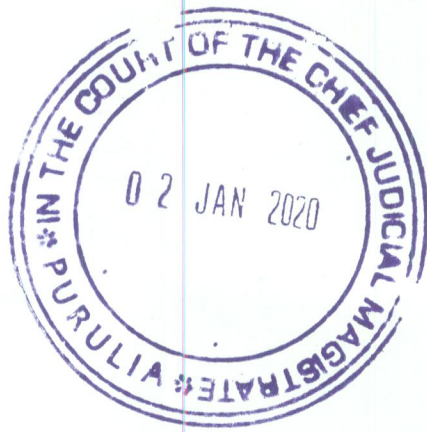

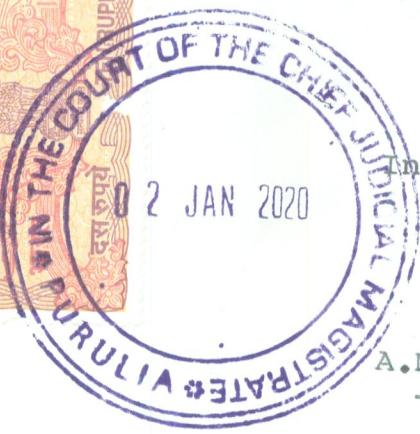

The ~~humbly~~ above-named complainant begs to state as follows:-

- 1.---That the properties described in the schedule of the Complaint is situated ~~also~~ at mouza- Gerua, P.S.Balarampur, Dist.Purulia, within the jurisdiction of this court.
- 2.---That the schedule land of this application was previously belonged to Haladhar Majhi and the schedule land has been recorded in C.S.Khatian No. 102 in his name and said Haladhar Majhi possessed the schedule land till his death.
- 3.---That said Haladhar Majhi died leaving behind his only son Fakir Majhi as his only legal heir. After the death of Haladhar Majhi, Fakir Majhi inherited the schedule land and came into actual physical possession and he also possessed the schedule land till his death. Said Fakir Majhi possessed the schedule land by using Khamar and producing Rabi crop such as Biri, Alti etc. upon the schedule land.
- 4.---That Fakir Majhi died leaving behind his only son Jagadish Majhi present complainant as his only legal heir. After the death of Fakir Majhi, Jagadish Majhi inherited the schedule land and came into physical possession. He also possessing the schedule land by producing ~~the schedule~~ land by producing Mug and Alti.

5.---That like previous years this year also present complainant planted Alti, Seem and Vandi upon the schedule land and grown the same. But on 20-10-2019 corresponding to 2nd Kartik 1426 B.S. at about 5 a.m. the present accused No.1 to 4 making an unlawful assembly with gravious weapons such Lathi, Tangi, Sickle, Spade etc. came near the schedule land and forcibly criminally trespassed the schedule land and started to cut the seem, Vandi and Alti ^{which} was ~~not~~ planted grown and produced the complainant. The complainant and his persons protested the afoesaid illegal acts of the accused persons, but the accused persons threatened to cause murder, greivous heart when the complainant and other asked them not to cut damage and not take away the Alti, Seem Vendi. The accused persons cut the Seem Vandi and Alti and taken away Sim, Alti and Vendi. The complainant sustained loss of Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand).

5.---That the accused persons are very dangerous and desperate in nature and became out of the threats and violence attitude of the accused persons the complainant and his persons were rendered helpless.

6.----That the complainant informed the aforesaid incident to the local police of Balarampur P.S. there after to the
