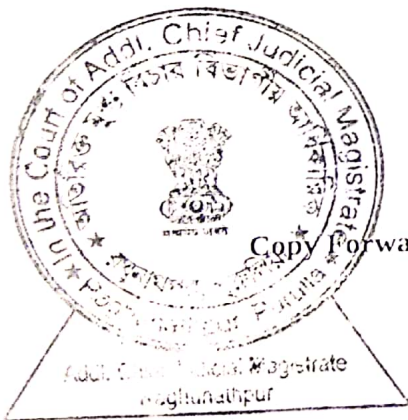

- 2) That, on 03/11/2019 the son of the petitioner namely Arjun Singh aged about 24 years was proceeding on one Bullet two wheeler vehicle bearing registration No. WB-56N/7388 which belongs to the petitioner and he was proceeding from Purulia to Raniganj through Raghunathpur-Bankura road by wearing his full helmet and when he reached near Kali Mandir at Raghunathpur-Bankura road under Raghunathpur police station at about 18.00 hours at that time one unknown truck of which registration number is not known to the petitioner, coming from the opposite direction being driven in a rash and negligent manner of the driving by the driver of the said truck dashed petitioner son's motor cycle bearing registration No. WB-56N/7388 as a result Arjun Singh fall down from the Bullet and became grievously injured. - 4) That, your petitioner had been to Raghunathpur police station but no any F.I.R was lodged till date.
- 5) That, your petitioner also informed the S.P Purulia, but no any action was taken place and no any F.I.R is lodged till date by the police of Raghunathpur P.S. hence this application.
