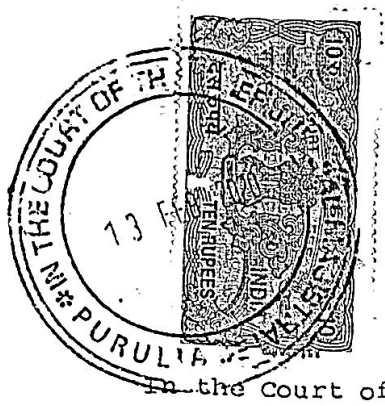

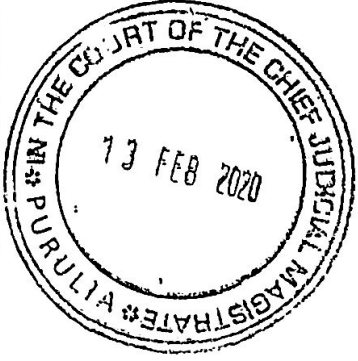

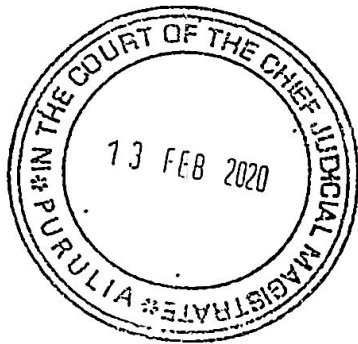

4. Offence committed by the Accused Persons abovenamed :-

U/S- ~~254~~ 421/425/445/379/120B/34 of I.P.C.

The petitioner most humbly and respectfully begs to state as under :-

1. That the petitioner/complainant is the resident of

Village- Pithatik~~to~~ tola Raherdih, P.S.- Arsha and under the jurisdiction of this Ld. Court.

2. That the father of the complainant during his life time purchased the piece of land at Kantadih beside 32 N.H. in the name of his elder brother Subodh Chandra Kundu to establish shop rooms for Subodh Chandra Kundu and the petitioner. The R.S. Plot No. of which is 1812/1840.
3. That thereafter Subodh Chandra Kundu established two shop rooms and the complainant raised one shop room for him over the said land and in the said shop room the complainant used to run a bi-cycle repairing shop since last 20 years.
4. That after demise of their father Subodh Ch. ~~Mahanta~~ Kundu used to claim ownership over the entire land on the plea that the title died in question is in the name of him and pressurised the complainant to leave and vacate the said shop room but as the complainant did not vacate the same Subodh Ch. Kundu in the year of 2013 filed title suit No. 78/2013 against the complainant before the Ld. Civil Judge (Senior Divn.) Purulia praying for recovery of possession by evicting the complainant from his his shop room but subsequently with the intervention of the other brothers and sisters of them Subodh Ch. Kundu admitted the right <sup>over</sup> ~~ax~~ the complainant and withdrawn the said suit.
5. That though Subodh Ch. Kundu in presence of his other brothers and sisters admitted the rights of the complainant but later on secretly by suppressing the fact

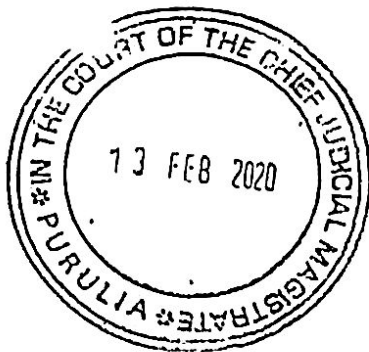
sold and transferred the entire land to Manik Ch. Mandal and Abedin Ansary.

6. That said Manik Chandra Mandal and Abedin Ansary when came to know about the fact then also admitted the right of the complainant and never disturbed/disputed the possession of the complainant over his shop room rather then mounted pressure upon their ~~under~~ Vender Subodh Ch. Kundu to return back 1/3 (one third) of consideration for the portion of the complainant.

7. That thereafter there was no dispute of the complainant with Manik Ch. Mandal and Abedin Ansary but all on a sudden from some day of November 2019 the accused persons above-named started giving him ultimatum to leave and vacate shop room at his own otherwise they shall disposses him by demolishing the shop room in question, but the complainant tried his best to make them understand.

8. That meanwhile on 26/11/2019 at morning when the complainant went to his shop room to open the same then he found his shop room was in ruined completely and all the machineries and new parts of cycle valued at least of Rs. 40,000/- taken away better to say theft by the accused persons which he came to know from the operator of J.C.B. Machine which was standing beside the road.

9. That in this way the accused persons committed theft mischief and other offences to the property of the complainant and his family members and the complainant has become completely hopeless and helpless. Contd...P/4.

10. That after such incident immediately thereafter the complainant lodged complaint to the O.C. Arsha P.S. but he did not take any step as the accused persons are influential persons and have political power. He also submitted application before the S.P. Purulia but all are in vain.

11. That under the circumstances stated above the accused persons are liable to be prosecuted as directly by them and at their instances theft, mischief and other offences committed upon the complainant.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour be graciously pleased to issue direction upon the O.C. Arsha P.S. to start a case under Sections as quoted hereinabove by treating this application as F.I.R. to deliver justice to the poor complainant.
