Sir,

I, SI Nimai Ch. Nemo of Jhalda P.S. returned to PS with force and brought under seizure 1) one blue colour Honda Livo Motor Cycle having No- JH09AD 1898 2) one white Red colour TVS Sports Motor Cycle having No- JH10AK 3078 and 3) one black & white Hero Honda Splendor Plus Motor Cycle having No- JH01 AK9783 and lodged this complaint against 1) owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH09AD 1898 2) owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH10AK 3078 and 3) owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH01 AK9783 and others to the effect that today (21/04/2020) myself along with force C/571- Md. Hasib Khan, C/497- Ambuj Kr. Mandal, LC/1053- Pratima Choudhury, Hav/1644- Ashok Tamang, R/M-548 Rudramoni Pratap was engaged in day mobile duty. During Day Mobile duty as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At 14:15 Hrs. when myself with force reached at Mosina more under Jhalda P.S. We found 03 (three) Motor cycles with three riders in each Motor cycles were plying in excessive speed, making Halla. We tried to intercept them. But riders of Motor cycles fled away seeing Police party leaving 03 (three) Motor Cycles on road. We tried to apprehend them but failed. So, there is every reason to believe that the riders of those 03 (Three) Motorcycles came out from their home and moving aimlessly or making fun. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule. So, I seized those Motor cycles with proper seizure list.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH09AD 1898 2) owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH10AK 3078 and 3) owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH01 AK9783 and others as they disobey Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated Quarantine rule U/S 188/269/270/271/279 IPC and 54 Disaster Management Act, 2005 and arrange for investigation.
