Sir,

With due respect I SI Montaz Sheikh beg to submit before you that on 28.04.2020 at about 16:45 hrs while myself along with force were performing mobile duty and found the following persons with their Motor Cycles noted against each, were roaming aimlessly at Kotshila bazaar area, Police party detained them at Kotshila Station More on Purulia-Ranchi- pitch road (SH-4A) under Kotshila-PS. On being asked the following persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak. Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020. As such the following persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till 03.05.2020. Moreover all the detained persons were refuses to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. All the accused persons also tried to negligently to spared infection of disease dangerous to life. Accordingly the following persons were arrested and seized 03 motor cycles from 17:35 Hrs. to 18:05 hrs. under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and the accused persons, after maintaining all formalities regarding arrest and seizure & prepared arrest memos and brought them to P.S
