Sub: Prayer for starting a specific case under proper section of law.

Sir,

In producing herewith one seized Dumper bearing No -WB 53A/9520, Engine-21D63254511 & Chassis No-MAT448109C3DI2331 loaded with raw coal of 06 M.T. (approx) do hereby lodge a complaint to the effect that on (24/04/2020), I, ASI Dibyendu Mahato along with (1) C/66 Kameshwar Pandey (2) C/1304 Dhananjay Mondal and (3) C/382 Bipad Taran Chatterjee all of Neturia PS were engaged in evening mobile duty vide Neturia PS GDE No-956 Dt. 24.04.2020 & CC No- 1128/2020 Dt. 24.04.2020. In course of evening Mobile Duty, at about 19:45 hrs when we reached near Jhanka More, I received an credible source information to the effect that one Dumper bearing No- WB 53A/9520 loaded with illegal coal coming from Madhukunda side and will transport the same to Raghunathpur side through Purulia - Barakar road in clandestine manner as per their regular practice. I immediately intimated to you over phone and acquainted you about the information and you directed me to work out the information. As per your direction I along with force immediately rushed towards Sarbari - Madhukunda road and while we reached at near Panchakot Filling Station where found one Dumper standing beside the road. Accordingly we got down from the Govt. vehicle and found that the number of the dumper WB 53A/9520 is matched given by my source and the dumper is loaded with raw coal of 06 M.T. (approx). On search we found that no one was present in the cabin of the dumper and the key of the dumper has been left away in the dumper by the driver. We searched the surrounding area with torch light to find out the driver or owner but failed to trace out.

So, there is reason to believe that the driver, owner of coal and registered owner of the said dumper have collected the said coal either by theft or by any fraudulent means and tried to dispose of the same coal in a clandestine manner to Raghunathpur side knowing it to be stolen, as per their regular practice.

Accordingly I seized the said dumper bearing no - WB 53A/9520 loaded with raw coal of 06 M.T. (approx) under proper seizure list duly signed by the Police witnesses in between 20.25 hrs and 20.45 hrs, since no public witness was found as well as seized approx 05 kg raw coal from the above noted seized dumper as sample and labeled the same.

Under the above circumstances a specific case may kindly be started against the (1) driver of dumper bearing registration No - WB 53A/9520 (2) owner of the coal, seized from dumper bearing registration No - WB 53A/9520 and (3) Registered owner of dumper bearing registration No - WB 53A/9520 under proper section of law.
