Sir,

In producing here with 05(Five) arrested accused persons namely 1) Jhantu Paramanik (33yrs) S/o Lt- Gabardhan Paramanik of Palma, 2)Rabi Roy (31yrs) S/o Ramesh Roy 3) Paresh Roy (42yrs) S/o Lt- Anil Roy 4) Narayan Chandra Saw (64yrs) S/o Lt- Ramkrishna Saw 5) Bijay Paswan (58yrs) S/o Lt- Pundag Paswan all of Village- Bajakrtar, all of PS Para, Dist Purulia.

I beg to state that today (22.04.2020), I was directed to find out whether the lock down has been implanted properly by Anara railway Market area or not. This refers to Anara OP under Para PS GDE No- 296 Dtd. 22/04/2020. Accordingly, I had been to market area at about 17.05 hrs and found that a gathering appeared in front of Anara Railway market, none of them was wearing musk.

They disclosed their identity noted above but cannot give satisfactory answer about their such type of activities, they also failed to give satisfactory answer for their such type of movement in indiscipline manner. They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated govt order.

I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e.as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 17.15 hrs to 17.35 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

After that I left for PS. On arrival at PS I type this letter of complaint at our PS computer and submitted to O.C Para PS through duty officer ASI Mrinmoy Choudhury for taking necessary action as per law.
