Sub: FIR

Sir,

I beg to state that today (10/05/2020), I along with my accompanied force namely C/942 Dipak Mukherjee & C/1130 Asik Ansary left for Barabazar market area with intend to observe Lock Down order passed by the State Government of W.B to prevent attack from **CORONA VIRUS/COVID-19** vide Barabazar PS GD entry no 517 Dtd. 10/05/2020. At about 09.05 hrs I reached near Chakbazar area and found one sweet shop near Chakbazar has been opened and seen the Police party the shopkeeper fled away. We tied to apprehend him but somehow he managed to evade Police apprehend.

I was directed to find out whether the lock down has been implanted properly by shopkeepers at Barabazar market area or not. Accordingly, I had been to here & there at market area and when I reached near Chakbazar Barabazar around 09.05 hrs and found that a gathering appeared in front of a sweet shop at Barabazar market near chakbazar which is opened and selling other than Non essential articles by the shopkeeper. Seen the Police party the mob fled away and the shop keeper managed to flee away.

Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till 17.05.2020.

Held an enquiry and from the locality it came to light that name & address of the shop keeper is **Debnath Sing Modak s/o Bibekananda Sing Modak of Vill+ PS Barabazar Dist Purulia** who opened his sweet shop, selling non essential goods & disobedience to order duly promulgated by govt. through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus. It is also revealed that said shopkeeper is very desperate, creating annoyance to the society by such type of illegal activities avoding govt order in this critical situation. The ambience of the shop and the shop keeper was found very much unhygienic and with any health care articles. This may spread infection. His malignant act is likely to spread infection of disease dangerous to life.

Finding no other alternative to prevent the such of type of activities and violation of Govt order,. As there was lock down in the town and Police appeared suddenly, the peoples left the place and did not agreed to come forward to remain present as witness. I also refrained myself from encouraging much people to come out from home to remain present in the Police work in this time of Lock Down. I took photograph of the open shop.

After that I left for PS. On arrival at PS I type this letter of complaint at our PS computer and submitted to I.C Barabazar through duty officer ASI Deb Kumar Chattaraj for taking necessary action against said shopkeeper namely **Debnath Sing Modak s/o Bibekananda Sing Modak of Vill+ PS Barabazar Dist Purulia** as per law.
