Sir,

I, LSI- Arpita Das of Jhalda P.S. returned to PS with ASI- Sk. Abdul Jamshed and force and brought under seizure 1) One blue & black colour Honda Sports Motor Cycle having No- TN07E 0335 2) One black colour Bajaj Discover-100 Motor Cycle having No- JH09R 2760 3) One Black colour Hero Honda Super splendor Motor Cycle having no JH10L 3959 and lodged this complaint against 1) Amit Rajak (29) S/O Dulal Rajak of Vill- Beladih, PS- Kotshila, Dist- Purulia 2) Rahul Rajak (18) S/O Fatick Rajak of Do 3) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- TN07E 0335 4) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH09R 2760 5) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH10L 3959 and others to the effect that today (11/05/2020) myself along with ASI- Sk. Abdul Jamshed and force C/1179- Pabitra Mandal was engaged in Spl. mobile duty. During Spl. Mobile duty as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At 19.25 Hrs. when myself with force was performing Naka checking at Bandhaghat under Jhalda P.S. above noted Motor cycles with three riders were detained as they were moving aimlessly and creating Halla. Two riders of Motor Cycle having No- TN07E 0335 could be apprehended but another rider of Motor Cycle having No- TN07E 0335 and riders of Motor cycle having No- JH09R 2760 and JH10L 3959 fled away leaving their Motor cycle on spot. We tried our level best to apprehend them but failed. I examined detained persons and during examination they disclosed their identity as noted above but they did not give proper reason why they came out from house and reached there. It is known that both accd. persons were riding in the Motor Cycle. They could not produce any documents related to this Motorcycle having No- TN07E 0335. So, there is every reason to believe that the riders of those Motorcycles came out from their home and moving aimlessly or making fun and they did not come for emergency purpose. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till 03.05.2020. Later on the order is extended till 17/05/2020. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule. So, I seized those Motor cycles with proper seizure list. I also arrested above noted accd. persons maintaining all formalities of arrest and later on released on bail considering present situation of epidemic COVID-19.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) Amit Rajak (29) S/O Dulal Rajak of Vill- Beladih, PS- Kotshila, Dist- Purulia 2) Rahul Rajak (18) S/O Fatick Rajak of Do 3) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- TN07E 0335 4) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH09R 2760 5) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH10L 3959 and others as they disobey Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule U/S 188/269/270/271 IPC and 51 Disaster Management Act, 2005 and arrange for investigation.
