Sir,

I, SI- Bikash Ch. Patra of Jhalda P.S. returned to PS with force and brought under seizure 1) One Red Colour Hero Achiever Motor Cycle having No- JH01 BL7413 2) One Black & Red colour Bajaj Platina Motor Cycle having No- JH09K 2383 3) One Black & Silver colour Hero Splender Plus Motor Cycle having No- JH01CM 8581 and lodged this complaint against 1) Sanjay Mahato (35) S/O Gunadhar Mahato of Vill-Losera, PO-Rampur, PS- Silli, Dist- Ranchi, Jharkhand 2) Manoj Paramanik (27) S/O Ram Paramanik of Vill-Bansha, PS- Jhalda, Dist- Purulia 3) Bhim Mahato (22) S/O Kedar Mahato of Vill-Raidih, PS- Jhalda, Dist- Purulia 4) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH01 BL7413 5) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH09K 2383 6) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH01CM 8581 and others to the effect that today (26/05/2020) myself along with force C/386- Sibendu Sinha, C/497- Ambuj Kr. Mandal was engaged in evening Spl. mobile duty. During evening Spl. mobile duty as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At 19.25 Hrs. when myself with force was performing Naka checking at Mosina more under Jhalda P.S. above noted Motor cycles with three riders were detained as they were moving aimlessly and creating Halla. Among three riders of Motor Cycles having No- i) JH01 BL7413 ii) JH09K 2383 and iii) JH01CM 8581 one person from each motor cycle could be apprehended and rest 02 (two) persons of each motor cycle fled away. We tried our level best to apprehend rest of them but failed. I examined detained persons and during examination they disclosed their identity as noted above but they did not give proper reason why they came out from house and reached there. It is known that Sl. No. 1) was riding in motor cycle no i) JH01 BL7413. Sl. No. 2) was riding in motor cycle no ii) JH09K 2383 and Sl. No. 3) was riding in motor cycle no iii) JH01CM 8581. They could not produce any documents related to their Motorcycles. So, there is every reason to believe that the riders of those Motorcycles came out from their home and moving aimlessly or making fun and they did not come for emergency purpose. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till 03.05.2020. Later on the order is extended till 31/05/2020. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule. So, I seized those Motor cycles with proper seizure list. I also arrested above noted accd. persons maintaining all formalities of arrest and later on released on bail considering present situation of epidemic COVID-19.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) Sanjay Mahato (35) S/O Gunadhar Mahato of Vill-Losera, PO-Rampur, PS- Silli, Dist- Ranchi, Jharkhand 2) Manoj Paramanik (27) S/O Ram Paramanik of Vill-Bansha, PS- Jhalda, Dist- Purulia 3) Bhim Mahato (22) S/O Kedar Mahato of Vill-Raidih, PS- Jhalda, Dist- Purulia 4) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH01 BL7413 5) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH09K 2383 6) Owner of Motor Cycle having No- JH01CM 8581 and others as they disobey Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule U/S 188/269/270/271 IPC and 51 Disaster Management Act, 2005 and arrange for investigation.
