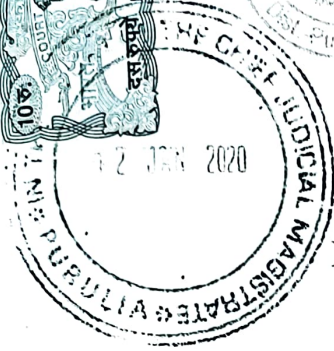

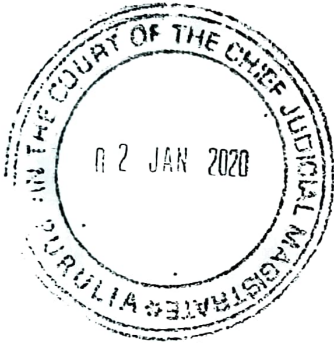

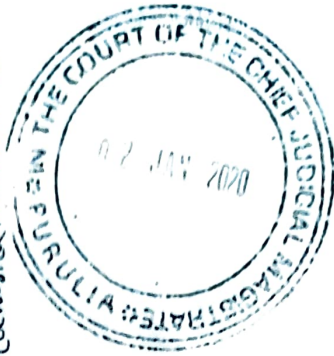

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no-1 Soumen Paul and their marriage was solemnized on 27/02/2012 as per Hindu Rites and Customs as prevalent in their community and also by observing the formalities like putting on vermilion, exchange of garlands, Home etc. and the said marriage is still subsisting.
- 2) That at the time of marriage as per demand of the accused persons a cash of Rs. 6,50,000/- golden ornaments valued of Rs. 4,50,000/- and other valuable furniture and articles.

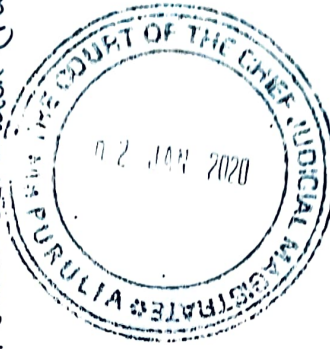

- 3) That after marriage the complainant was brought in to her matrimonial house and started her matrimonial journey with the accused person no-1 as husband and wife along with other inmates of the family, with the same house and roof and accordingly the complainant started her matrimonial journey with all her hopes locked in to her heart. Initially the nature of the parties however somehow well and good but after two months from the date of marriage the accused persons started ill behaved in a very unusual manner with some unusual gesture which indicated somehow rather otherwise in the mind of the complainant, but the complainant initially did not take it to be so abnormal on the hope that everything would be normal after passage of time.

While the complainant was at her matrimonial house she was blessed a son namely Amrit Paul who is aged about 5 years 2 months.

- 4) That while the complainant was at her matrimonial house she was not provided proper food and clothing even daily

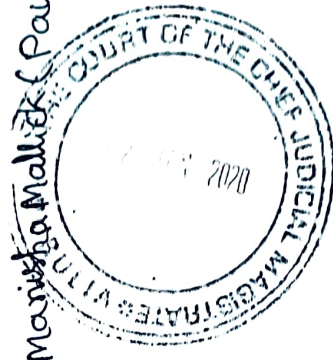

necessity and also not provided baby food etc to the newly born son for which the complainant was very much socked, but she never disclosed before then her anxiety.

- 5) That gradually all the accused person with common intention started all sorts of inhuman, physical as well as mental torture upon her , they also even assaulted upon the complainant mercilessly for which the complainant had to treat in the Government Hospital. The intention of the accused person to contact second marriage of the husband of the complainant and when that intention they occasionally tried to kill her.
- 6) That the accused persons with her such ill intention practically snatched all the ornaments from which were under the custody of the complainant and they have by that time misappropriate all those ornaments behind the back and knowledge of the complainant, sometimes the accused persons put the complainant in a room and locked the room from the outside so that no one could know the torture inflicted upon her by the accused persons.

- 7) That in course of persistent torture upon the complainant all the accused persons asked the complainant to bring Rs. 70,000/- from her father as additional dowry contrary to that they disclosed that they will not allowed to the complainant to stay in their house. When their such illegal demand was not fulfilled they increased the degree of torture which became untolarable to the complainant.
- 8) That the dispute and / or the torture upon the complainant was occasionally placed before the Salish committee, but they did not honour their verdict.
- 9) That ultimately all the accused persons assaulted the complainant mercilessly and driven her out from their house on 15/02/2019 and the complainant somehow came to her paternal house with her minor baby to save her life and since she is residing at her paternal house.
- 10) That when the complainant is residing at her paternal house none of the accused persons ever taken any information nor they have taken any steps to bring her back to her matrimonial house , rather the accused persons

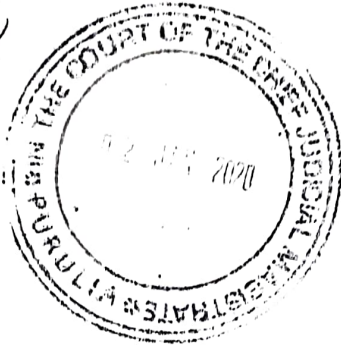

no-1 i.e. the husband of the complainant abused the complainant in various slang language with his mobile set and also send those defamatory statement through whatsaap, face book and SMS, some of the abusive / defamatory message send by the accused no-1 has taken print out and kept her custody of the complainant as evidence.

- 11) That torture upon the complainant in such manner in continuing while the complainant is residing at her paternal house which is within Purulia town, under Purlia Town P.S.
- 12) That the matter was informed to the Officer-in-charge Purulia Town P.S. but the said Officer-in-charge did not taken any legal action then the complainant lodged another complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia, but with same fate.
- 13) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code including section

498A/323/34 I.P.C for which they are deserved to be punished under the law.

- 14) That no legal action yet been taken against the accused persons from the side of the Police for which the complainant is under compelling circumstances is filing this complaint before the Id. Court.

It is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to sent the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge Purulia Town P.S. for treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation .
