Sir.

In producing herewith the arrested accused person namely Mritunjoy Singh (30) S/o Lt. Surendra Singh of Habaspur, PS – Barun, Dist.- Aurangabad, Bihar, driver of truck No. JH 10J/3119 and seized truck No. JH 10J/3119 loaded with approx 25 MT coal. Fact of the case in brief is that on 14.05.2020 myself along with C/844 Tufan Swadagar and C/929 Rajendra Das of Raghunathpur PS were performing Evening Mobile Duty on Raghunathpur – Bankura road and at about 18:15 hrs. received a source information that the above noted truck loaded with coal was coming from Santuri side towards Raghunathpur side. After receiving such information I informed the matter to IC Raghunathpur PS and as per his kind direction we had been to Raghunathpur – Bankura road (SH-8) near at Chinpina Rly. Gate and waiting for the said truck and at about 20:05 hrs found that the above noted truck is coming from Santuri side. We stopped the said truck and on searching it is found that the said truck was loaded with approx 25 MT coal and on asking driver of the said truck failed to produce any papers in respect of said coal as well as papers in respect of the said truck. He also made incoherent statement in respect of possession of the said coal in his truck which he was driving. So, it is reasonable to believe that the driver and owner of the said truck collected the said coal either by theft or by any fraudulent means from anywhere and transporting the same to run clandestine business for wrongful gains. On interrogation the driver of the said truck confessed his guilt. As such it is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said truck No. JH 10J/3119 transporting coal illegally. As such I arrested the accused driver of above noted truck namely Mritunjoy Singh (30) S/o Lt. Surendra Singh of Habaspur, PS – Barun, Dist.- Aurangabad, Bihar after observing all formalities and narrating him the ground of arrest. I also seized the truck having registration No. JH 10J/3119 loaded with approx 25 MT's stolen coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accused driver and witnesses. No public witness was available there. Approx 01 (One) K.G. of Coal sealed & labeled as sample coal from major contraband.

I therefore pray before you, kindly lodge an FIR against the driver namely Mritunjoy Singh (30) S/o Lt. Surendra Singh of Habaspur, PS – Barun, Dist.- Aurangabad, Bihar and owner of the truck bearing No JH 10J/3119 as per law and arrange for its investigation.
