Respected Sir

With due respect, I am to report that today (21/05/2020) at 09:24 hrs received one telephonic information from one Ashim Acheryya, CVF of Gurudih village under Barrah GP, PS-Raghunathpur, Dist-Purulia, that one Lahabar Mahato (55) S/o Dharani Mahato of Gurudih, PS -Raghunathpur, Dist-Purulia came from Jhalsukra, Orissa on 20/05/2020 and he was medically check-up at Raghunathpur SS Hospital Fluc Corner where on duty MO advised him to stay at Home for 14 days as Home Quarantine, but he did not pay any heed to the Govt. Order as well as advice of MO. After such information as per order said CV Ashim Acheryya visited his house as routine check-up, but the said Lahabar Mahato was not present in his house and came to learnt that Lahabar Mahato left his house since morning on 21/05/20.

After getting such information, as per order of IC Raghunathpur PS, I, SI Jayanta Kumar Chakraborty, Anchal Officer of Barrah GP left to work out the information after diaries the fact in General Diary vide Raghunathpur PS vide GDE No. 780 dated 21/05/2020 and directed VP Jiban Chakraborty of Barrah GP for enquired into the matter.

At about 09:40 Hrs VP Jiban Chakraborty informed me that during his visit of Home Quarantine Persons at Tarapur village with CV/Ganesh Mahato, he found said Lahabar Mahato of Gurudih village is moving aimlessly at Tarapur village area and he requested said Lahabar Mahato to go to home, but he did not pay any heed to his word and left for another side.

At about 10:45 hrs I had been to village Gurudih and enquired into the matter locally and during enquiry I visited the house of Lahabar Mahato, but he was not available in his house as well as Gurudih village.

So, it is well established that he is violating the rules and norms as per order in this pandemic Covid-19 situation vide Order No. H&FW-118-20 dated 16/03/2020 Govt. Of West Bengal, Health and Family Welfare Department, Swasthya Bhawan, GN -29, Sector-V, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-91 and will responsible for spreading the deceased in the community and also liable to prosecuted as per law.

I, therefore, pray before you, necessary legal action may kindly taken against the said Lahabar Mahato (55) S/o Dharani Mahato of Gurudih, PS - Raghunathpur, Dist-Purulia by registering a case under proper section of law and thus obliged.
