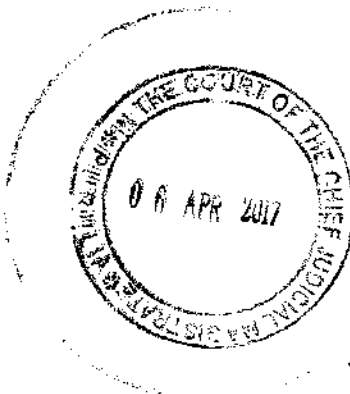

Begs to state as follows :-

1... That on the date of occurrence at about 5 A.M. in the morning the accused persons being armed with deadly weopnse Lathi Axes in their hands began to cut off the roof of the tree. The accused No. 1 began to cut off the roof of the trees and the accused No. 2 began to cut off

the branches of the tree which was standing in R. S. Plot No. 319 of Mouza Deoli which has been recorded in the name of the complainant and his brother, wherein a Ghamar tree the length of which is 10 feet and breadth of which was 6 feet under valuation of tree was Rs. 7,000/- in total.

2... That the complainant heard the noise of cutting off the tree and he came to the spot and found that the accused No. 1 and 2 were cutting off the tree and the other accused persons were provoking the accused persons to cut off the said tree and the branches of the tree. Witness No. 1 also came to the spot and found the occurrence. The complainant and the witness jointly asked them that why they are cutting of the tree but the accused persons threatened the complainant and the witness to assault or murder if they prevent them from doing the unlawful act of cutting of the tree and branches of the tree. The complainant has/had being in possession of the aforesaid plot along with the tree is standing on the plot of the land. They do not care for the request of the complainant and they cutoff the entire roof of the tree before two days back they cut off one half portion but yesterday they cut off the entire root of the tree. They have no right, title or possession over the land or over the tree standing on the plot of land. The complainant is the rightful owner of the plot of the land of the tree which was standing on the plot of land. The accused persons have criminally trespassed

into the land, they have cause mischief to the land and they have caused an offence of theft and receiving of stolen property in their unlawful custody. The accused persons do not care for any law and they have removed the branches of the tree but still now, the wood of the tree is now fallen under the soil of R.S. Plot No. 319 which has been recorded in the name of the complainant and his younger brother. The aforesaid tree was standing in the western portion of R.S. Plot No. 319. The accused persons could not remove the wood of the tree till now although they have cutoff the branches of the tree and the root of the tree. The aforesaid tree or the wood of the tree should be seized by the Officer-in-charge Balarampur Police Station immediately, Otherwise the filing of the instant case will found to be infructuous.

It is prayed that your Honour be pleased enough to pass necessary order to treat this petition as F.I.R. U/S 156(3) of Criminal Procedure Code.
