




The humble petition U/S 156 (3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 on behalf of the petitioner above named;

Most respectfully begs to state:

- 1. That the petitioner is legally married wife of the accused No.1 which is still subsisting between them.
- 2. That the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized at Village Sagma, P.S: Balarampur, District: Purulia, on 10/3/2016 and prior to the marriage the accused persons demanded Rs.5 lakhs from the father of the petitioner and they stated that they would purchase Gold Ornaments, Furniture, Cot and Beddings as well others furniture in lieu of the marriage at Jamshedpur as they would get proper choicest articles there unlikely to get the same at Sagma.



- 3. That at the time of marriage the father of the petitioner gave one 1 ½ bhori Gold chain but again on demand of the accused persons the father of the petitioner had to purchase one Gold chain of ½ bhori for my Husband just before solemnization of marriage as the accused persons gave threats that they would take away the groom from the marriage canopy.
- 4. That after marriage the petitioner along with these articles and ornaments was taken to her matrimonial house at Telco Plaza, Riverview, Quarter no. 29/1, Jamshedpur, P.O: Telco Plaza Market, P.S: Telco, District: East Signbhum and started residing with her husband, the accused No.1, the accused No. 2 & No. 3 are the parents-in-law and accused no. 4 is the niece of the accused no.1.
- 5. That soon after the marriage, the accused No. 1 along with other inmates of the house, (the accused No. 2 to 4) became hostile towards Petitioner on the plea of a demand of an Almirah. The accused persons started creating consistent pressure upon the petitioner.
- 6. That in spite of continuous pressure the petitioner tried to convince the accused persons by saying that the petitioner is not in a position to meet more demands of the accused persons. The accused person being aware of the petitioner's health condition which was severely deteriorated refused to give any medical aid or allowed the petitioner to take medicine. Furthermore, the accused no.2, mother-in-law despite knowing that the petitioner was suffering from Low Blood Pressure forced the petitioner to all the domestic affairs.
- 7. That in the meantime the petitioner was pregnant and the opposite parties started pressuring the petitioner's father to take her with him and accordingly at the time of Durga Puja (2016) the petitioner's father took her to Lucknow, his working place.



- 8. That on 22nd November 2016 the petitioner gave birth to a male child but since the health condition of the petitioner was not proper the child was underweight and died after 41 days of his birth. Surprisingly, the accused and his family members never took any information about the birth of the child and neither made any call with regards to his death.
- 9. That subsequently on repeated occasions, after several trials by the petitioner and her father, the petitioner went back to her matrimonial house, but all calls to the accused remained unanswered, and neither the mother in law, accused no.3 allowed the petitioner to talk to the husband and asked the petitioner to say at her parental house.
- 10. That the petitioner went to Balarampur P.S but the police refused to take any action.
- 11. That the matter was reported to S.P., Purulia on 22.3.2017, but no action was taken.
- 12. That your petitioner is a female and this case requires through police probe including examination of witnesses who are residents of different places, seizure of articles, documents, etc.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to direct the police of Balarampur P.S to treat this petition as a F. I. R. and to cause investigation in respect of the alleged incident.

And for which act of kindness, your petitioner, as in duty bound shall ever pray.
