Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against accused Nayan Mahanto (32 Yrs) S/O Ganesh Mahanto of Arrah, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia and 25-30 others of Arrah village.

Sir,

I SI Manas Kr. Panda of Adra PS do here by lodged a complaint against above noted accused persons and 25-30 others of Arrah village. To the effect that on 01.06.2020 at about 12.35 hrs receive a information from Shri Anirban Mondal, BDO, Raghunathpur-1 that some villagers of Arrah village create a cerotic situation in front of Arrah Panchayat office, Community Hall which is treated as quarantine center by State Govt. As per order of O/C Adra PS I along with force left for Arrah village to work out the matter. When I reached at the spot I found that a assembly of 25-30 villagers of Arrah village under the leader ship of Nayan Mahanto (32 Yrs) S/O Ganesh Mahanto of Arrah, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia create a cerotic situation regarding the quarantine center at Arrah Panchayat office Community Hall. They demanded that they have objection if this place treated as Intuitional quarantine center and they will not obey the state government decision regarding this. I tried to convince them and repeatedly request them not to assemble in this pandemic situation. But they did not pay any heed to me and even the mob shows rough behavior and gesture posture to me. Finding no other way I tried to detain them but all of them fled away. Though lockdown is going on throughout all over India in view of Pandemic of COIVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India, the villagers of Arrah village under the leadership of above noted person violated the order during this pandemic situation.

Hence I there for pray that a specific case may kindly be started against above mentioned persons U/S 143/186/188 IPC & Section 51 (1) (b) in the National Disaster Management Act, 2005.
