Begs to state as follows :-

1. That Ananta Lal Mahato, the father of the petitioner/ complainant is the owner of the property situated in Mouza- Kerrow, Pargana Barabhum, P.S.- Barabazar, District- Purulia, bearing (a) R.S. Khatian No. 83, R.S. Plot No. 238/561 area 3 acre 6 dec. out of it 17 dec. (b) R.S. Khatian No. 23, R.S. Plot No. 238/561 area 3 acre 6 dec. out of it 17 dec. (c) R.S. Khatian No. 24, R.S. Plot No. 238/561 area 3 acre 6 dec. out of it 17 dec. (total area 51 dec.) out of which 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  dec. in the middle portion of the plot adjacent to Kerrow-Bhongradih Kancha Rasta and the rest 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  dec. is on

2. That the complainant has filed an application U/S- 144 Cr.P.C. before the Ld. S.D.E.M. Purulia against the accused persons, which was registered as Misc. Case No. 320/2016 for restraining the O.P. members/accused persons from interfering with the possession of the petitioner in respect of the aforesaid property.

3. That in the above mentioned case after hearing the matter Ld. Court has been pleased to draw up a proceeding U/S- 144 Cr.P.C. against the O.P. members, restraining them not to disturb the peaceful possession of the petitioner till the disposal of the case with a

direction to O.C. Barabazar P.S. to comply the order and also maintain peace and tranquility in the locality vide order dated 25/11/2016.

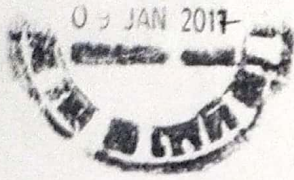
4. That after obtaining the order and after compliance of the same, your petitioner went to the schedule land on 28/12/2016 at about 7.15 a.m. for developing his uneven danga land by engaging J.C.B. bearing No. JF-05-AJ-1912 in the share of his father and also by demolishing the dilapidated boundary wall, which stands in the share of his father mentioned above, but the O.P. members came to the spot and raised objection, used slang languages with dire consequences and create violent situation and forced the driver of the J.C.B. bearing No. JF-05-AJ-1912 and the petitioner to stop the work.

5. That your petitioner tried to convince the O.P. members that he has obtained order from the Ld. Court but the O.P. members did not pay any heed to it.

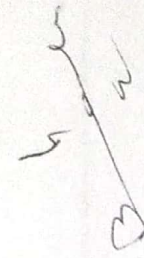
6. That your petitioner informed the matter to the Barabazar Police Station and the Barabazar Police Station asked the petitioner to inform the matter before the Ld. Court.

7. That the Ld. <sup>S.O.E.H.</sup> Court has promulgated the order and directed the O.P. members to abstain from any act upon the schedule land of the petitioner, but the O.P. members has made disobedience to order duly promulgated by the Ld. Court which cause obstruction, annoyance, or injury and has violated the court's order.

8. That your petitioner informed the matter before the S.P. ~~Barabazar~~ on 30/12/2016, for violating the court's order by the O.P. members, the xerox copy of the same is enclosed herewith.

9. That the accused persons have criminally trespassed and unlawfully assembled into the land of the petitioner and damaged the J.C.B. Machine/vehicle.

10. That the accused persons with their female members tried to assault the petitioner only to create a false case against the complainant.

11. That the incident has been witnessed by the witnesses.

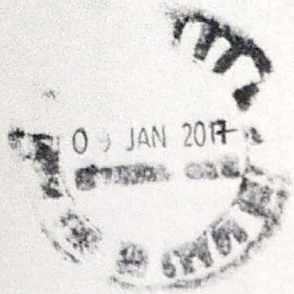
12. That the O.P. members knowing fully well of the order passed by the Ld. Court, in C/w the above mentioned case has violated the court's order duly promulgated by the Ld. Court which the offender intends to cause obstruction, annoyance, injury and harm.

13. That the order dated 25/11/2016 has been duly served upon the O.P. members by the O.C. Barabazar P.S.

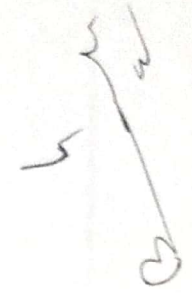

18. That the accused persons have wrongfully restrained the petitioner from going into his land.
19. That the accused persons have used criminal force and tried to assault the petitioner intending to dishonour the complainant/petitioner. *2 stolen away the articles.*
20. That the above offences are of such nature that Police Investigation is required for the ends of Justice and to bring the offenders to Book.
21. That the accused persons are also giving threat to the petitioner.
