Sub: Complaint U/S- 46A (c) The Bengal Excise Act against Rajesh Hembram (26 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Chaitan Hembram of Village- Jamboni, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia to start a specific case.

Sir,

In producing here with one Rajesh Hembram (26 Yrs) S/o-Lt. Chaitan Hembram of Village- Jamboni, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia under arrest and the one Jaricane (plastic) containing 15(fifteen) lts of ID liquor. 500 ml ID liquors kept as sample article under seizure as per enclosed seizure list.

I, ASI Baninath Mukherjee of Barabazar PS do here by lodge this complaint as suo-moto against Rajesh Hembram (26 Yrs) S/o-Lt. Chaitan Hembram of Village- Jamboni, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia that today (21.03.2017) at evening received a source information that one for unauthorized selling of ID liquor. I have been then verified the credibility of that information and immediately conveyed the information to the duty officer ASI Sarif Ali Khan of Barabazar PS who noted down the information vide Barabazar PS GDE No- 1080 Dt. 21.03.2017 and asked me to work out the information as per order of I.C Barabazar PS. Accordingly myself along with forces with PS vehicle having No WB- 26K/5475 left for Tentlo village to work out the information we had been at Tentlo village and held raid in the open field of Tentlo village and found one person was selling ID liquor. On seeing the police party, he had made a deliberate attempt to fled-away but failed as we had taken care of in all side and managed to apprehend him and asked his identity, he stated his identity as Rajesh Hembram (26 Yrs) S/o-Lt. Chaitan Hembram of Village- Jamboni, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia. On being search, found one Jaricane (plastic) containing 15 (fifteen) liters of ID liquor. On being asked he stated that he has been selling the ID liquor to make his profit. He also admitted that he had no license or any authority to sell those ID liquor to his customers. Accordingly, I seized the above noted article after preparing a proper seizure list and put label on the seized article in presence of witnesses and one bottle 500 ml ID liquors kept as sample taken from that seizure as sample which was also duly labeled and also took signature of the accompanying witness on seizer list and label. It took time from 16.45 hrs to 17.10 hrs. Thereafter, I secured arrest of said Rajesh Hembram (26 Yrs) S/o-Lt. Chaitan Hembram of Village- Jamboni, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia after preparing Memo of arrest & after observing all other formalities of arrest. Informed him and his relatives regarding the ground of arrest. The arrest was made at 17.15 hrs.

Under the above circumstances I, therefore, pray that a specific case U/S- 46 (A) (c) of The Bengal Excise Act. may kindly be registered against said Rajesh Hembram (26 Yrs) S/o-Lt. Chaitan Hembram of Village- Jamboni, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia and also for arranging its investigation.
