Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Sanjit Sharma S/O Late Rohan Sharma of Vill – Hanspahari, PS – Chatna, Dist – Bankura along with one seized vehicle (TATA 2515 truck) bearing registration No. WB55A/5963 loaded with approx 18 ton white quartz stone to the effect that on 10.06.2020 evening I along with C/181 Rabban Seikh and C/994 Srikanta Kumbhakar were performing evening mobile duty on Bandwan- Manbazar road. During mobile duty at about 19:35 hrs received a credible source information that the above noted truck is coming from Jambeda village side towards Shimultol more on Bandwan- Manbazar road loaded with white quartz stone. After receiving this information we were proceeding towards Shimultol more under Boro P.S. We reached at Shimultol more under Boro P.S. at about 20.05 hrs and after few minutes found that the above noted truck was coming from Jambeda village side. We put signal to the driver to stop. The driver stopped the vehicle. On being asked the driver stated his name as Sanjit Sharma S/O Late Rohan Sharma of Vill – Hanspahari, PS – Chatna, Dist – Bankura. We searched the said truck and found that the truck bearing registration No. WB55A/5963 is loaded with approx 18 ton white quartz stone. I asked the driver to produce any valid documents in respect of the loaded stone in the truck as well as the valid documents in respect of that truck but he could not produce the same. On further interrogation he stated that he loaded this stone near Jambeda village as per order of the owner of the truck bearing registration No WB55A/5963 and the proprietor of S.K. Enterprise who is a lease holder of a stone quarry at Chalka Mouza under Boro PS. Hence I seized the truck bearing registration No WB55A/5963 loaded with approx 18 ton white quartz stone under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter we brought the said truck to Boro P.S. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the vehicle bearing registration No WB55A/5963 and the proprietor of S.K. Enterprise who is a lease holder of a stone quarry at Chalka Mouza are transporting quartz illegally with ill motive without any valid document from other area except their lease area. So they are liable for offence punishable U/S 379/411/414/120B IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.

Therefore, I pray before you to register a case against Sanjit Sharma S/O Late Rohan Sharma of Vill – Hanspahari, PS – Chatna, Dist – Bankura and the owner of the truck bearing registration No WB55A/5963 and the proprietor of S.K. Enterprise who is a lease holder of a stone quarry at Chalka Mouza under Boro PS under proper sections of law and to arrange for its investigation.
