begs to state :-

- 1) _____ That, your Complainant is the permanent resident of Balarampur Station Para Balarampur, P.S. - Balarampur, Dist. - Purulia and the accused persons as mentioned above are also the resident of Balarampur P.S. - Balarampur, Dist. - Purulia.
- 2) _____ That, your Petitioner/Complainant is a **business** businessman having business at Calcutta and occasionally he visits his native place Balarampur having a pucca residential building.
- 3) _____ That, on 13/11/2014 your Complainant ^{with his wife} came from Calcutta and reached Balarampur at his residential house at that time he saw that all the accused persons being armed with gaiti, Shovel, lathi, Tangi etc, breaking open the door of your Complainant in his own residential house possessed by him, the Complainant raised objection and protest to that effect but the accused persons became furious and

took an attempt to kill him looted all the house hold articles belonged to him like furniture, (Sofa Set) wooden Chair, Table, Cotr with bedding, Gas Cylinder oven, valuable documents, gold ornament weighting 30 Bhories, T.V. , FreeZe, PAN Card, Voter Card, etc. amounting to ~~Rs~~ Rupees about four to Five Lakhs and after committing theft of these articles they took away aforesaid articles to their house.

4) _____ That, your Complainant rushed to the P.S. reported the matter but neither the O/C nor the S.P., Purulia took steps in this regard as all the accused persons are the members of the Ruling Party.

5) _____ That, thereafter your Complainant filed one Writ Petition being No. 4484(W) of 2015 Binod Kumar Saw - Vs.- State of W.B. against the accused persons and the District Authority but the LD, Lawyer of the Complainant did not appear and the same was dismissed with the observation on 07/01/2016 that - " It is the grievance of the Petitioner that in spite of repeated complaints to the Police Authorities no steps have been taken against the private respondents, who are committing Criminal activities.

It is open to the Petitioner to initiate appropriate criminal proceedings against the Private respondents

Nobody appears for the Petitioner when the matter is called on.

Accordingly, the writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution."
