Petitioner Most respectfully beg to state as follows :-

- 1) That the petitioner/ complainant and the accused persons are the residents of the village under Jhalda Police Station within Purulia District which is under your jurisdiction.
- 2) That the accused persons were well acquainted with the complainant and both of them used to maintain a good and courteous relation between them before some days.
- 3) That the accused persons, being the law owner of the scheduled land mentioned below proposed your petitioner/ the complainant to purchase 10 decimals of their lawfully owned land in exchange of Rs. 50,000/- as the market rate of that land and they also informed the complainant to give them such amount on an agreement to be executed by them as land lord as they were in very urgent need of such amount.
- 4) That the complainant was also looking for such land for his persons use and agreed to purchase the proposed land measuring an area of 10 decimals.
- 5) That on 04/10/2015 an agreement on a Non-Judicial Stamp was drafted and written by the witness no.-1 being an Amin in presence of other witnesses and witness No.-1 being the than Pradhan of Mathari-Khamar Panchayet signed

over the agreement paper knowing all the terms mentioned in that agreement and the three accused persons signed over the agreement in presence of all the witnesses on 01/10/2015 and the complainant handed over an amount of Rs. 40,000/- and the accused persons took the amount and promised to obey all the terms mentioned in the agreement executed by them in presence of all the witnesses. (Annexure-A)

- 6) That A Civil case was initiated by one Daman Mahato against Charubala Mahato, i.e. Accused no.-2 in reference with title of R.S. plot no. 18 measuring an area of 1.33 decimal being the part of land of this instant case and in a terms of the agreement relating to this case it was agreed by the accused persons that as and when that case will be settled they will execute sale-deed in favour of the complainant within seven days..
- 7) That the case was settled and the dispute between the parties was finished before some days as it was informed by the accused persons to the complainant and other witnesses.

- 8) That after seven days from such settlement the complainant requested the accused persons to execute sale deed and to take Rs. 10 000/- as the last payment of the cost of the land measuring 10 decimals, but the accused persons started avoiding the complainant in different pretensions.
- 9) That the complainant went to Jhajda Police Station on 20/10/2016 to lodge a complaint, but saying the matter related with land, the duty officer suggested your petitioner to file Civil Case before the competent Court of Law. (Annexure - 13)
- 10) That being compelled, the complainant send a pleader's notice on 25/10/2016 requesting the accused persons to remain present on 16/11/2016 in the shresta of a deed writer, but the accused persons nor replied the pleader's notice duly received by him nor attended before the deed writer to execute sale deed and as such the accused persons cheated the complainant. (Annexure - 5).
- 11) That your petitioner i.e. the complainant made several request before the accused persons through the witnesses, but the accused persons flatly denied to execute any sale deed and they declared that they have settled their mind to sell the land in question to other agreed parties on high rate.
