Sir,

In producing herewith one seized vehicle (Tractor) bearing registration No. WB55/6065 loaded with sand. The fact of the case in brief is that on 29/03/2017 night I along with force were on night mobile duty on Kashipur - Chatna road. During mobile duty on 29/03/17 at about 05:15 hrs received a credible source information that the above noted (Tractor) is coming from Sutaboi side towards Gourangdih morh loaded with sand. After receiving this information we were proceeding towards Gourangdih More under kashipur P.S. When we reached near Gourangdih morh under Kashipur P.S, found that the above noted (Tractor) was coming from Sutaboi village. On seeing the Police party the driver of the said tractor stopped the tractor in a distance from Gourangdih morh and tried to unload the sand loaded in the said tractor. We rushed to the tractor and the driver then fled away after keeping the tractor near Gourangdih morh at 05:45 hrs. We searched the said tractor and found that the tractor is loaded with sand. I searched for any valid documents in respect of sand loaded in the tractor as well as the valid documents in respect of that tractor but nothing found. Hence I seized the tractor bearing registration No WB55/6065 loaded with sand in the trolley under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter arranging a driver from my source I brought the said tractor to Kashipur P.S. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the vehicle bearing registration No WB55/6065 with ill motive are transporting sand illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand. So they are liable for offence punishable U/S 379/411/414/120B IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.

Therefore, I pray before you that a case against the driver and owner of vehicle (Tractor) bearing registration No WB55/6065 may kindly be started and arrange for its investigation.
