


In producing herewith one seized vehicle (Tractor) bearing registration No. WB 55A/1097 loaded with sand in a trolley I SI Partha Kumar Bhunia, O/C Kashipur PS do here by lodged complaint against the driver and owner of vehicle (Tractor) bearing registration No. WB 55A/1097 as suo motto to the effect that on 02/04/2017 I along with force were on day mobile duty on Kashipur - Chatna road. During mobile duty on 02/04/17 at about 11:35 hrs received a credible source information that the above noted (Tractor) is coming from Narayangarh side towards Majramura morh loaded with sand. After receiving this information we were proceeding towards Majramura More under Kashipur P.S. When we reached near Majramura morh under Kashipur P.S, found that the above noted (Tractor) was coming from Narayangarh village. On seeing the Police party the driver of the said tractor stopped the tractor in a distance from Majramura morh and tried to unload the sand loaded in the said tractor. We rushed to the tractor then the driver fled away after keeping the tractor near Majramura morh at 12:05 hrs. We searched the said tractor and found that the tractor is loaded with sand. I searched for any valid documents in respect of sand loaded in the tractor as well as the valid documents in respect of that tractor but nothing found. Hence I seized the tractor bearing registration No WB 55A/1097 loaded with sand in the trolley under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter arranging a driver from my source I brought the said tractor to Kashipur P.S. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the vehicle bearing registration No WB 55A/1097 transporting sand illegally with ill motive without any valid document in support of carrying sand. So they are liable for offence punishable U/S-379/411/414/120B IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.
