Sir,

I, SI Indrajit Sarkar of Manbazar P.S. returned to PS with force and lodged this complaint as suemoto against (1) Prankrishna Kumbhakar (50) S/O Lt Dharmeswar Kumbhakar of village Kodma PS Manbazar District Purulia (2) Bhaktaranjan Kumbhakar (20) S/O Prankrishna Kumbhakar of village Kodma PS Manbazar District Purulia (3) Dadhilochan Mahato (59) S/O Lt Sarish Mahato of village Kodma PS Manbazar District Purulia (4) Ananda Baskey (46) S/O Sudhir Baskey of village Jorberia PS Manbazar District Purulia (5) Bikash Baskey (18) S/O Banamali Baskey of village Jorberia PS Manbazar District Purulia (6) Haripada Mandi (26) S/O Sibhaprasad Mandi of village Dhadkigora PS Manbazar District Purulia (7) Hirulal Kumbhakar (21) S/O Sagar Kumbhakar of village Rajagram PS Bandwan District Purulia (8) Gorupada Kumbhakar (38) S/O Narayan Kumbhakar of village Rajagram PS Bandwan District Purulia (9) Rabibal Kumar (30) S/O Dasarath Kumar village Choto Kodam PS Boro District Purulia to the effect that today i.e. on 26.06.2020 myself along with force were engaged on Mobile duty vide Manbazar PS G.D.E No- 1191 Dtd-26.06.20. Accordingly, I had been to Manbazar near post office more at about 12:05 hrs I found that the above persons with their Motor Cycles (03 persons in each Motorcycle) were roaming aimlessly at Manbazar near post office more. Myself alongwith force detained them at Manbazar post office more on Purulia Boro Road under Manbazar PS. On being asked the above accused persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated- 25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 11 & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till date. Moreover all the detained persons were refuses to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. All the accused persons also tried negligently to spare infection of disease dangerous to life.

I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. More over they driven the vehicles on public way in rush and negligently as to endanger to human life. I seized :-

- i) One New Glaumour (Black & Blue) Motor cycle bearing Engine No. JA06ERK37576, Chassis No. MBE9AW101KKGK36007 Driven by Prankrishna Kumbhakar (50) S/O Lt Dharmeswar Kumbhakar of village Kodma PS Manbazar District Purulia along with 02 others as noted above in SI No. 2 & 3.
- ii) One New Super Splendar BS6 Motor cycle bearing Chassis No. MBLJW17429C10197, Engine No. JA07ABL9C20223 driven by Haripada Mandi (26) S/O Sibhaprasad Mandi of village Dhadkigora PS Manbazar District Purulia District Purulia along with 02 others as noted above in SI No. 4 & 5.
