
Sub : Dacoity, hurt, criminal intimidation and wrongful restraint committed by (1) Sushanta Chatterjee, son of not known, (2) Nitu Chatterjee, son of Ramdulal Chatterjee, (3) Tufan Chatterjee, son of not known, (4) Bapan Chatterjee, son of not known, (5) Ramdulal Chatterjee, son of not known, nos. (1) to (5) all residing at Harekrishnapur, Manbazar, Purulia, West Bengal, Pin - 723131, in criminal conspiracy with each other.

Respected Sir,

I, Mithun Sahis, son of Baikuntho Sahis, presently residing at Banshpahari, Odalchua, Banshpahari, Paschim Medinipur, Binpur-II, West Bengal - 721 501, am forced to bring to your notice the offences committed by (1) Sushanta Chatterjee, son of not known, (2) Nitu Chatterjee, son of Ramdulal Chatterjee,, (3) Tufan Chatterjee, son of not known, (4) Bapan Chatterjee, son of not known, (5) Ramdulal Chatterjee, son of not known, nos. (1) to (5) all residing at Harekrishnapur, Manbazar, Purulia, West Bengal, Pin - 723131.

My employer, Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh, was approached by Mr. Nitu Chatterjee, in the year 2017, with a proposal for investment and work in connection with the sand mining lease allotted to Nitu Chatterjee in Palasbani - 2, Sand Mine, proposing that Mr. Ali shall control and finance the mining of sand and in return, 70 % of the profit, after deduction of all Capital & Operational expenditure, shall go to Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh and the remaining 30 % of the said profits to Mr. Nitu Chatterjee.

Upon accepting the proposal of Mr. Nitu Chatterjee, Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh had deputed me, along with two other colleagues, namely Tapas Mahato and

Umapada Banerjee, to manage and operate the aforesaid sand mine with due notice and communication with the above accused. We had accordingly set up a makeshift work area by the Sand Mine at Mouza Palasbani, J.L. No. 65, bearing Plot No. 205, under PS - Manbazar, District - Purulia.

On the 3rd of June, 2020, the three of us (I, Tapas Mahato and Umapada Banerjee) had come to work as usual. At about 5pm, suddenly Sushanta Chatterjee, Nitu Chatterjee, Tufan Chatterjee, Bapan Chatterjee and Ramdulal Chatterjee arrived and surrounded us at our makeshift work area. Nitu Chatterjee immediately started abusing us and asked us to leave the place and gave us life threats if we ever came back for the sand mine. I and my colleagues were extremely shocked.


I tried to reason with Mr. Nitu Chatterjee that I have been given the job to oversee the sand mining work as per the agreement between Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh and Nitu Chatterjee, which is now in its third year, and if Mr. Chatterjee has anything to say, he could speak with Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh. At this, Nitu Chatterjee got furious and said that he did not need Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh any more, and this was peak season to make profit. Without giving us a second more, Mr. Ramdulal Chatterjee exhorted Tufan, Bapan and Nitu to assault us and kept abusing us in filthy language and gave us life threats. The three of us (I, Tapas Mahato and Umapada Banerjee) are small wage earning employees and the Chatterjees are local strongmen who have immense clout in the area. We were overpowered and fisted and slapped by Sushanta Chatterjee, Nitu Chatterjee, Tufan Chatterjee, Bapan Chatterjee, when Ramdulal Chatterjee asked me to hand the cash bag in my possession. I protested that it was the money entrusted to me by Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh for operation of the sand mine, when Tufan held me by the collar. As Umapada and Tapas protested to this, Bapan Chatterjee, Nitu Chatterjee and Sushanta Chatterjee slapped them indiscriminately and commanded us to hand over the cash. Tufan showed a knife to me and said that he would kill us if we resisted and so saying, the accused restrained us.

We (I, Tapas Mahato and Umapada Banerjee) were unarmed and were trembling with fear, when Ramdulal Chatterjee snatched the cash bag from me and emptied the contents and counted the cash which came to Rs. 1 lakh. Nitu, Sushanta, Bapan, Tufan and Ramdulal then left with the cash of Rs. 1 lakh and also our pen drive, our HP laptop and our HP printer. Before leaving, Nitu Chatterjee threatened that if they ever see us again in Manbazar, let alone Palasbani, we shall lose our lives. He also added that he had contacts in high places and the law would never catch up with them.

Sir, we are extremely scared and have not returned to the sand mine site thereafter. We are fearing for our lives as Sushanta Chatterjee, Nitu Chatterjee, Tufan Chatterjee, Bapan Chatterjee and Ramdulal Chatterjee are extremely powerful local people who are capable of carrying out their threats of causing grave harm to us. Under such threats, I had left for my native place at Medinipur immediately and for fear of the said persons, I could not come earlier to your good-self. Finally, after somehow availing the present scarce transport under lockdown, I have gathered courage to lodge this complaint with you as Rs. 1 lakh, pen drive, laptop and printer, all entrusted to me by Mr. Asraf Ali Shaikh, for which I was accountable, has been looted by the aforesaid accused persons and I pray before you for recovery of the same.

Sir, it is apparent that the five accused persons in criminal conspiracy with each other have committed dacoity by wrongfully restraining me and my colleagues, causing us hurt and putting us in fear of death and hurt by showing us a knife, in order to loot Rs. 1 lakh, pen drive, laptop and printer from us.

Sir, the acts of the aforesaid accused persons clearly reveal commission of offences punishable under sections 120B/323/325/341/395/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code. In such circumstances, I do hereby beseech your good office for taking necessary action by registering this letter of complaint as a First Information Report and by arresting the aforesaid accused persons for their misdeeds and to recover our Rs. 1 lakh, pen drive, laptop and printer .
