The above named complainant begs to state:-

1...That the complainant's husband Mukshaed Ansary runs a shoe house named Pini shoe store at village paradih, P.S. Puncha, District Purulia having Trade Licence which is vary near from the house of complainant's native village.

2...That on 28.11.2016 the husband of complainant was not present he went to outside of village and complain-

3....That on 28.11.2016 at about 11-00 A.M. the accused Ajit Sing and Srikanta Murmu entered into the shoe house and threatened the complainant, asked where-about of Mukshed, the complainant did not disclose the actual where-about of her husband Mukshed as because before 5/6 days the accused had threatened her husband with dire consequences . When the accused became more violent.

4...That there after, both the accused persons took the shoes of the shoe house loaded in a rickshaw van and taken away all shoes . The value of the stolen shoes will be Rs. 1,00,000/- (rupees one lakh)

5...That the complainant narrated the incident of theft of shoes to her husband and other on the night when her husband returned.

6....That on the next morning , the complainant and her husband lodged dairy at Pancha P.S. against the accused persons regarding the incident dated 28.11.2016 but the police did not take any action ~~show~~, the complainant compelled to file the complain to S.P. ~~for~~ Purulia on 14.12.2016 but the S.P. Purulia also did not take any action against the accused persons and so, the complainant compelled this complain before this court.

7....That the complainant was waiting for police action and hence this delay.
