Sir,

In producing here with 03(Three) arrested accused persons namely (1) Balaram Saren(22), S/O- Gokul Saren of vill-Paisagora, PS-Boro, Dist- Purulia (2) Priyaranjan Baskey(23), S/O- Ajit Kumar Baskey of do (3) Uttam Majhi(25), S/O- Rampada Majhi of vill+PO-Ranga, PS- Hirbandh, Dist. Bankura along with seized motor Cycle Hero HF Deluxe bearing Regn. No JH05-AU/3974, seizure list, Memo of arrest & other relevant papers.

I beg to state that today (21.06.2020) at 12:15 hrs. I was engaged in mobile duty at Budpur area with special mobile officer and force to find out whether the lock down has been implanted properly at PS jurisdiction area or not. This refers to Puncha PS GDE No- 1171 Dtd. 21.06.2020 and CC No-1750 Date- 21.06.2020. Accordingly, I was performing duty near Gadapathar at Sriramghutu area. At about 13:25 hrs I found that the above noted persons with their Motor Cycle, were roaming aimlessly at Sriramghutu area. I along with force detained them at Sriramghutu on Manbazar-Bankura road under Puncha PS. On being asked the above accused persons could not give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place. They were also driving the motor cycle on public way in rash and negligent manner as to endanger to human life. On being asked they did not produce the valid documents in respect of said motor cycle as well as driving license and all the detained persons refused to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. All the accused persons also rode negligently to spread infection of disease dangerous to life. There was every chance of breach of peace and repeating of offence if not arrested. They disobeyed the order duly promulgated by Govt. through public servants and through media etc. for prevention of attack from Corona virus/Covid-19. They were creating annoyance to the society & violated Govt. order.

They disclosed their identity as noted above but cannot give satisfactory answer about their such type of activities and running motor cycle dangerously with three persons in one motor cycle(without wearing mask and without maintaining social distance) having Reg. No. JH05-AU/3974 and without using headgear. Finding no other alternative I arrested them for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant; after maintaining all formalities. Issued Arrest Memo. I informed them the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. At prima facie there were sufficient grounds to secure their detention. I also seized their vehicle. i.e. one Hero HF Deluxe motor cycle bearing registration no- JH05-AU/3974 under proper seizure list duly signed by the accused persons and witnesses. All the process was done in between 13:25 hrs and 13:55 hrs. I offered them bail but they could not produce any surety.

As there is lock down in the area the peoples left the place and did not agreed to come forward to remain present as witness in the seizure process. I also refrained myself from encouraging much people to come out from home to remain present in the Police work in this time of Lock Down.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case may kindly be started against (1) Balaram Saren(22), S/O- Gokul Saren of vill-Paisagora, PS-Boro, Dist- Purulia (2) Priyaranjan Baskey(23), S/O- Ajit Kumar Baskey of do (3) Uttam Majhi(25), S/O- Rampada Majhi of vill+PO-Ranga, PS- Hirbandh, Dist. Bankura as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life, U/S 188/269/270/279/34 IPC and Sec 51(a)(b) of National Disaster Management Act, 2005 and also driving of motor cycle on public way in rash and negligent manner as to endanger to human life U/S 128/129/181/184 of MV Act and arrange for its investigation.
