Sir,

In producing herewith one seized vehicle (Tractor) bearing registration No. WB/55A-4489 loaded with sand. The fact of the case in brief is that on today i.e. 13/01/2017 evening I along with force were on mobile duty on Purulia- Ranchi road. During mobile duty on today i.e. 13.01.2017 at about 17:50 hrs received a credible source information that the above noted (Tractor) is coming from Garafushra side towards Chas Morh loaded with sand. After receiving this information we were proceeding towards Garafushra village under Purulia (M) P.S. When we reached near Garafushra village under Purulia (M) P.S, found that the driver of the said tractor was coming from Garafushra side. On seeing the Police party the driver of the said tractor stopped the tractor in a distance from Garafushra Village Morh. We rushed to the tractor and the driver then fled away after keeping the tractor near Garafushra village at 18:35 hrs. I searched for any valid documents in respect of sand loaded in the tractor as well as the valid documents in respect of that tractor but nothing found. Hence I seized the tractor bearing registration No WB/55A-4489 loaded with sand under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter arranging a driver from my source I brought the said tractor to Purulia (M) P.S. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the vehicle bearing registration No WB/55A-4489 with ill motive are transporting sand illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand. So they are liable for offence punishable U/S 379/411/414/120B IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.

Therefore, I pray before you that a case against the driver and owner of vehicle (Tractor) bearing registration No WB/55A-4489 may kindly be started and arrange for its investigation.
