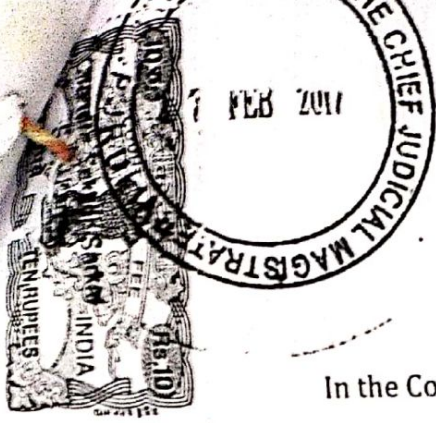

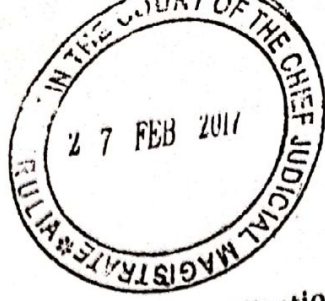

In the matter of an application u/s 156 (3) Cr.P.C.

The Complainant named above begs to state as follows:-

1) That the Complainant is a resident of Dulmi-Nadiha, Das Para, 40 Quarter, Near Kali Mandir, P.O-Dulmi-Nadiha, P.S-Purulia(T), Dist-Purulia. The Witness no-2 is the wife of the Complainant, Witness no-3 is the full brother of the Complainant and Witnesses no-4 and 5 are the sister-in-laws of the Complainant. Witnesses no-6 to 8 are the neighbours of the Complainant. All the Accused Persons are also residents of the same locality and they are neighbours as well as are the agnates of the Complainant.

2) That the wife of the Accused no-2 namely Smt. Anjali Das is the relative of the Complainant. Since after the marriage of Anjali Das with the Accused no-2 Amar Das, all the Accused Persons, who happen to be the in-laws of said Anjali Das, started to ill treat her and started torture upon her both physically and mentally. Being the relative of Anjali Das, the Complainant and his family members always protested against such ill treatment of the Accused Persons and always raised objection against such illegal activities of the Accused Persons. Some time the Complainant as well as his other family members along with some other neighbours also rescued said Anjali Das from being tortured by the Accused Persons and thus the Accused Persons did not like the Complainant and his other family members and as such their relationship with the Accused Persons became bitterer day by day.

Be it mentioned here that subsequently said Anjali Das lodged a Written Complaint against the Accused Persons for such torture upon her. The Accused Persons think that being provoked by the Complainant and his other family members, Anjali filed the very case against them which is far from the truth. For such misconception of the fact, they often used to threaten the Complainant and his family members of dire consequences and often used to abuse them with filthy languages.

3) That on 31/01/2017 corresponding to 17<sup>th</sup> day of Magh, 1423 B.S. at about 8.00 a.m, the Complainant had been to the nearby water tank behind his house at some distance from their residence to collect drinking water and at that time the Witness no-2, the wife of the Complainant was brushing her mouth at the outside of her house, then suddenly the Accused no-6 Adari Das started to abuse the wife of the Complainant with filthy languages. While the wife of the Complainant raised objection against hurling of such abusive language by Adari Das, then the Accused Persons namely Chinta Das, Dipali Das, Sajani Das along with said Adari Das(Accused no-3 to 6), in furtherance

of the common intention of all of them, started assaulting the wife of the Complainant mercilessly with fists and blows as well as by kicks. At that time, the Complainant was returning from the water tank and hearing hue and cry of her wife, he rushed to his house and saw that the above mentioned accused persons assaulting his wife mercilessly. He then tried to save her wife from the clutches of the accused persons as named above. When all of a sudden, the accused Pintu Das and Amar Das brought Lathi, Tangi, Iron Rod etc. from their house and joined the above named female accused persons and thus forming an unlawful assembly started assaulting the Complainant. The Accused Pintu Das assaulted the Complainant by Lathi on his head for which the Complainant sustained bleeding injury on his head. He also sustained eye injury for such assault. Said Amar Das also by a Tangi and Iron Rod assaulted the Complainant on his right leg for which he sustained bleeding injury on his right leg also. For the aforesaid assault the Complainant fell down on the ground with bleeding injuries on his person. All the accused persons then conjointly with the intention of killing the Complainant and his wife started to assault them by Tangi, Rod, Lathi and by bricks mercilessly. They openly held out threat to the Complainant and his wife by saying that they will soon put the Complainant and his other family members in much more dire consequences.

- 4) That hearing the hue and cry, the other witnesses, as well as some other persons, neighbours of the Complainant rushed to the P.O. and seeing them to come, the accused persons fled away from the spot.
- 5) That both the Complainant and his wife sustained various injuries over their persons due to the assault by the Accused Persons as stated herein above.
- 6) That the other witnesses and the neighbours of the Complainant took the Complainant and his wife to their house and with the help of the local people and the other witnesses, the Complainant immediately went to the Purulia (T) P.S. and narrated all the incident to the police officer of the Purulia (T) P.S. and the Police who was in-charge at that time assured the Complainant and his associates that they would take legal action against the accused persons and told the Complainant to go to Hospital immediately as the Complainant sustained severe head injury and accordingly from the P.S, the Complainant along with his wife, with the help of the witnesses and the para people, went to the Deben Mahato Sadar Hospital, Purulia wherein they both were treated medically and on that day the head injury of the Complainant was stitched at the Operation Theatre of the said Hospital by the then Medical Officer-in-Charge of the Male General Ward.





It should be mentioned here that for such injuries on the head and eyes of the Complainant, his vision became gloomy and for the very problem he could not see properly till today. He therefore had to be medically treated by the Dr. Alok Kumar Kundu, M.O, Department of Eye of Deben Mahato Sadar Hospital, Purulia on the very date of incident as well as on 02/02/2017 and is still under the medical treatment and is going on taking medicines as per the prescription of the Doctor.

- 7) Thereafter the Complainant on several occasions visited Purulia(T) P.S. and all time, the Police assured him that they will take appropriate step against the Accused Persons. But as no step was taken by the Police of Purulia(T) P.S. in the very matter, the Complainant on 04/02/2017 informed the matter to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia. The Complainant also informed the very matter to the District Magistrate on 16/2/17 but even then as no step has been taken against the Accused Persons by the police, the Complainant has been compelled to lodge this Petition u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. before Your Honour's Court.
- 8) That the Accused Persons have thus committed offences punishable u/s 147/323/ 324/325/326/~~327~~/506 I.P.C.
- 9) That the Complainant being a helpless and poor person is unable to arrange for producing the Witnesses in Court. Moreover some of the Injury Reports of the Complainant and his wife are yet to be collected from Sadar Hospital, Purulia and the incriminating weapons are to be recovered from the Accused Persons which could not be possible without police help.

In the circumstances stated above, it is prayed that Your Honour may be graciously pleased to send this Complaint to the O.C.Purulia(T) P.S with a direction to treat the same as F.I.R. and to start investigation in the matter and to Prosecute the Accused Persons as per Law.
