Sir,

This is to inform you that I, the undersigned has been posted as **Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Purulia** vide the Hon'ble High Court's **Appellate Side, Calcutta, Notification No.5327-A dated 02-12-16** and as such, presently I am residing at Flat No.201 (2nd Floor), Narayani Complex, Saheb Bandh, Opposite Science Museum, Purulia-723101. I further like to draw your attention that on 29-05-17 at around 6:00 P.M. to 6:30 P.M., one of our maids namely Anjana Bagdi has come to our house for cleaning utensils as usual. On being asked by my mother, Smt. Bani Paul whether she can put oil and give a massage to her or not, she has replied in the affirmative. Thereafter, she has told my mother to open from her neck her gold chain (having weight of over one bhoori approx) gifted to her by her matrimonial great grand mother-in-law (Didi Sasuri) during her marriage. Needless to say that for that reason, we have no document in respect thereof. Accordingly, she has opened the same and put it on the bed and the said maid, Anjana Bagdi has started giving her massage. Suddenly, the calling bell has rung and she has got up to open the door.

It is pertinent to mention here that I have been in the kitchen at the relevant point of time. To be more precise, at that time only myself, my mother and the said maid, Anjana Bagdi have been present in the flat. After opening of the door, Anjana Bagdi has again entered into the said Purulia room to take back her mobile and thereafter, she has left the flat. It will also not be out of place to state that in that very evening, I have entered into the said room and slept for a while, but no such chain has even been noticed by me.

Subsequently, my mother has forgotten about the fact of wearing of the said gold chain and in the night, all three of us i.e. myself, my mother and my three year old son have slept on the said bed. In the next morning, i.e. on 30-05-2017, I have attended my Court early in the morning. As per my mother's version, she has suddenly discovered that she is not wearing the said gold

chain as has been asked by another maid, Ruby Mukherjee nor the same is lying on the said bed. Accordingly, she and another maid namely Ruby Mukherjee have searched for it with the assistance of my Home-Guard, Uttam Kumar, but the same has not been traced out. My mother has requested Anjana Bagdi to search for it in the late noon when she has come for working again and also stated that if she has taken the same, she is at liberty to return it and that, in such event, no legal step will be taken against her. However, she has flatly denied of taking the said gold chain, but has admitted that she has also seen my mother to open and put it on the bed.

It is pertinent to mention here that no FIR has been lodged even on 31-05-2017 by me as I have wanted to give Anjana Bagdi another opportunity to rectify her mistake, if committed. Be it mentioned here that my father (Sri N. C. Paul), my husband (Sri Indrajit Chatterjee), my aunt (Sandhya Paul) and my niece (minor Debadrita Paul) have assembled on the following day of the incident i.e. on 30-05-2017 due to the auspicious occasion of "Jamai Shosthi" and I and my mother have not told them about the mishap immediately so as not to spoil that day and also not to embarrass Anjana in front of them. To elaborate, if she has at all taken the said gold chain, we have given her the opportunity for two days more to bring the same back and keep it at a conspicuous place beyond our knowledge, so that later on, we obtain it and she also gets recovered from the aforesaid allegation. In simple words, this is the reason behind the delay in lodging the instant FIR.

However, in spite of giving her such chance and even after searching for it thoroughly for three days, when it is still missing, I have been compelled to lodge this FIR today, though delayed due to the aforesaid reason.

This is for your kind information and taking necessary action at the earliest.
