Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused Raju Chatterjee & 03(Three) others.

Sir,

In producing here with 04 (Four) arrested accused namely (1) Raju Chatterjee (30), s/o- Lt. Laxmikanta Chatterjee of Ram Mandir (2) M.D Sikander (50), s/o- Lt. Md. Selim of Upper Jhariadih, Adra (3) Gopal Kachap (36) S/O Bablu Kachap of Ram Mandir (4) Debdas Bauri (35) S/O Lt. Balaram Bauri of Dubradih near Hari Mandir, all of PS-Adra, Dist-Purulia along with Memo of Arrest.

I ASI Parimal Tewary of Adra PS do here by lodged a complaint against above noted 04(Four) accused persons to the effect that on 15.07.2020 at about 20.45 hrs while I was on evening mobile duty at PS area vide C.C No- 2359/20 dtd 15/07/20 found few persons were gathered Kali More under Adra P.S Dist- Purulia without maintaining social distance and without wearing mask. I aware them and directed them to send back at their respective destination as they were violating the Govt. order. But after several attempts they pay no heed to me. Finding no other way we tried to detained them. After seeing the Police party they were trying to flee away after a hot chase we managed to detained above noted 04(Four) persons and found that they were not wearing any mask and cloth covered to their mouth and nose. COVID – 19 Pandemic guidelines is going on throughout the country as well as District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak. They were disobeyed the guide lines of COVID 19 pandemic and to maintain social distance but they did not pay any heed. Consequently, it reasoned to believe they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this Pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of India vide order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I (A) dated 1/5/2020 read with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 272-CS/2020 Dated 30/06/2020 and 382-I.S.S/2M-24/2020 dtd.02/07/20. As such the following persons violated the order during this pandemic situation. Moreover the detained persons were refused to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. Accordingly the following 04 (Four) persons were arrested in between 21.05 Hrs to 21.35 Hrs. after maintaining all formalities regarding arrest and brought them to P.S. I offered them for medical checkup but they denied.

Hence I there for pray that a specific case may kindly be started against above mentioned persons U/S 188/34 IPC & Section 51 (1) (b) in the National Disaster Management Act, 2005.
