In producing herewith 08(Eight) accused persons namely 1.Jagadish Mahato (28 Yrs), S/O- Umesh Mahato of Vill- Haridih, 2.Mantu Chandra (51 yrs), S/O- Shaktipada Chandra of Vill- Bgahmundi, 3.Dipankar Kumar (32 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Shyamchand Kumar of Vill- Gobindapur, 4.Buddheswar Kumar (47 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Sanu Kumar of Vill-Chatatar, PS- Baghmundi, 5.Ranjit Machuar (45 Yrs), S/O- Gobinda Machuar of Vill- Dava 6.Mukunda Mahato (35 Yrs), S/O-Lt-Ananta Mahato, 7.Sonaram Tantubai (36 Yrs), S/O-Lt-Radhu Tantubai, 8.Gobinda Mahato (42 Yrs), S/O-Lt-Ananta Mahato all of Vill-Burda and all are of PS-Baghmundi, Dist-Purulia to the effect that on 25/07/2020 while I SI Sudhir Kumar Mahato along with force 1) C/610 Achinta Bauri and 2) JC/549-Arun Kumar Duley both of Baghmundi PS were performing mobile duty vide Baghmundi PS GDE No- 1182, Dated- 25/07/2020. During my mobile duty when myself along with force reached at Saragdih More at 17:25 hrs and found above noted persons were roaming aimlessly at said place without mask or its alternative. I detained them. On being asked the above accused persons disclosed their identity as above but could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place.

As the pandemic period related to COVID-19 is going on and hence to prevent its mass spreading the Central Govt. & State Govt. has passed order to wear mask in the public place mandatory and ordered to prosecute the defaulters. The order of West Bengal Govt is order no 382-1.S.S./2M-24/2020 Dtd 02.07.2020.

As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal hence the detained persons is refuses to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic after several request.

Hence I pray before you to start a specific case against the above noted persons under proper section of law.
