Today (25.07.2020) myself SI Bhudev Ch. Kuiry along with force JC/611 Bikash Kisku & JC/622 Debasish Mishra to were engaged in Spl. mobile duty vide C.C NO- 3106/2020, GDE No- 1232 dt- 25.07.2020 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At about 17:25 Hrs, when myself along with force reached at Balarampur market area near Ghosh Medical under Balarampur P.S. we found 05 (five) persons namely 1) Sarju Ansary (18 yrs) S/O- Lt. Yalish Ansary of Vill- Daily market, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Md. Hasim (18 yrs) S/O- Md. Kalim of Vill- Daily market, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Ujir Ansary (40 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ranjan Ansary of Vill- Bagjobra, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 4) Asif Ansary (40 yrs) S/O- Fazal Ansary of Vill- Haripaldih, Dist.- Purulia & 5) Jaladhar Paramanik (22 yrs) S/O- Chandra Mohan Paramanik of Vill- Namsole, Bansdih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia without having mask were moving aimlessly without any reason. There is every chance to believe that the above noted 05 (five) persons came out from their home to making fun and halla at Balarampur market area, though lockdown is going on throughout all over West Bengal in view of Pandemic of COIVD-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 and recent Memo No- 283-CS/2020 date-21.07.2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 272-CS/2020 dated 30.06.2020 Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest guided by NHRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against 05 (five) persons namely 1) Sarju Ansary (18 yrs) S/O- Lt. Yalish Ansary of Vill- Daily market, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Md. Hasim (18 yrs) S/O- Md. Kalim of Vill- Daily market, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Ujir Ansary (40 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ranjan Ansary of Vill- Bagjobra, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 4) Asif Ansary (40 yrs) S/O- Fazal Ansary of Vill- Haripaldih, Dist.- Purulia & 5) Jaladhar Paramanik (22 yrs) S/O- Chandra Mohan Paramanik of Vill- Namsole, Bansdih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia
