Today (25.07.2020) myself SI Satrughna Mahato along with force C/144 Saktipada Murmu, C/497 Arjun Halder, C/472 Prakash Das to were engaged in Spl. mobile duty vide C.C NO- 3099/2020, GDE No- 1204 dt- 25.07.20 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At about 18:35 Hrs, when myself along with force reached at Balarampur Station area under Balarampur P.S. we found 05 (five) persons namely 1) Nilambar Majhi (29 yrs) S/O- Mahabir Majhi of Vill- Sringi, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Rajib Karmakar (32 yrs) S/O- Sudhir Karmakar of Vill- Siringi, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Bijoy Kumar (22 yrs) S/O- Niranjana Kumar of Vill- Rerangtar, P.S- Baghmundih, Dist.- Purulia, 4) Madhab Das (21 yrs) S/O-Bablu Das of Vill- Rerangtar, P.S- Baghmundih, Dist.- Purulia & 5) Asit Tudu (18 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ladu Tudu of Vill- Salbani, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia without having mask were moving aimlessly without any reason. There is every chance to believe that the above noted 05 (five) persons came out from their home to making fun and halla at Balarampur Station area, though lockdown is going on throughout all over West Bengal in view of Pandemic of COIVD-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated- 25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 and recent Memo No- 283-CS/2020 date-21.07.2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 272-CS/2020 dated 30.06.2020 Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest guided by NHRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against 05 (five) persons namely 1) Nilambar Majhi (29 yrs) S/O- Mahabir Majhi of Vill- Sringi, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Rajib Karmakar (32 yrs) S/O- Sudhir Karmakar of Vill- Siringi, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Bijoy Kumar (22 yrs) S/O- Niranjana Kumar of Vill- Rerangtar, P.S- Baghmundih, Dist.- Purulia, 4) Madhab Das (21 yrs) S/O-Bablu Das of Vill- Rerangtar, P.S- Baghmundih, Dist.- Purulia & 5) Asit Tudu (18 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ladu Tudu of Vill- Salbani, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia.
