In producing here with the following seized motorcycle 1) One Black colour Hero Honda Splendor Motorcycle bearing Registration number-WB56D/9858 and do here by lodge a suo motu complaint against the owner of above noted Motorcycle.

Today (30.06/2020) myself SI Sukumar Hota along with force JC/716 Pintu Mandal & JC/ 1083 Uttam Kumar Mahato were engaged in Spl. mobile duty vide CC NO- 2732/20, GDE No- 1289 dt- 30.06.20 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At about 01:35 Hrs, when myself along with force reached at Balarampur Chowk Bazar more under Balarampur P.S. we found 01 (one) Motor cycle with three riders in the Motor cycle not wearing mask were plying in excessive speed, making chaos in the area. We tried to intercept them But riders of Motor cycle fled away seeing Police party leaving the Motor Cycle on road. We tried to apprehend them but failed. So, there is every reason to believe that the riders of this 01 (one) Motorcycle came out from their home and moving aimlessly for making fun. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COIVD-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till 17.05.2020. Later on order extended to 31.05.20. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule. So, I seized those above noted Motor cycles with proper seizure list.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against the owner of the following motorcycle.
