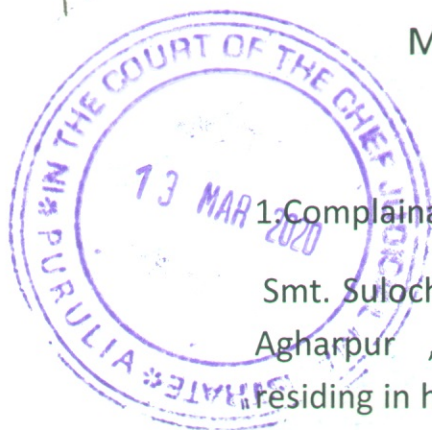

4. Occurrence :- From the very inception of marriage i.e. from 28th. Baisakh 1423 B.S. and onwards and on 15th. Magh 1425 B.s. at village Agharpur , P.S. Joypur , District Purulia (W.B.) .



5. Offences :- U/S 498A, 323, 506/34 I.P.C.& 3 and 4 D.P. Act.

The above named complainant begs to state

as follows:-

1---- That your petitioner is the legally married wife of accused Jukti Gope . The parties are Gowala by caste and Hindu by religion . Their marriage was solemnised on 28th. Baisakh 1423 B.S. according to their customary rites and formalities prevalent in their community . Their marriage was duly consummated and out of their wed lock a female child is born to them but unfortunately expired due to lack of treatment and negligence by the accused persons . The marriage tie between the parties still in subsistence .

2----That at the time of marriage , as per demand of the accused persons , her poor father had to give considerable dowry including a hard cash of Rs. 1,65,000/-, ornaments, utensils , Bedding , Dressing Table etc. to accused Jukti Gope and his inmates by selling his cultivable land but the accused persons were not satisfied with the same .

3----That after marriage , your petitioner went to her matrimonial home and lives there as husband and wife with accused Jukti Gope for about 10/12 days peacefully . thereafter her husband in collusion accused Sabitri Gope wife of late Sripati Gope , Mukti Gope , Rohit Gope both sons of late Sripati Gope and Sushila Gope W/O Sri Mukti Gope jointly started to torture the complainant mentally and physically. Her husband and other accused persons made a fresh demand of Rs. 50,000/- and asked her bring the same from her father otherwise she have no place in her matrimonial home they threatened but her poor father unable to meet the fresh demand and for that unbearable torture and assault were exercised upon the petitioner by the accused persons . To take revenge upon her husband and the other accused persons stopped her square meals and she was denied bare necessities of life .

4----That during her stay in her matrimonial home , your petitioner became pregnant and knowing the pregnancy of your petitioner , the accused persons became furious and vindictive upon the petitioner , drove her out from her matrimonial home after severe assault. Finding no other alternative , she took shelter in her father's house under compulsion and on 6th. Aghrahyayan 1425 B.S. she gave birth to a female bay at

Deben Mahato Sadar Hospital Purulia . As she gave birth to a female baby neither her husband nor any of the accused persons came to see her and her baby . All the expenses were borne by her poor father . After discharge from Hospital she went to her paternal house along with her baby .



5---That waiting for two months or so , her father reached her and the baby to her matrimonial home in the month of Magh 1425 B.S. but the accused persons shows gross negligence and refusal upon the petitioner and her baby and in this way , her baby was became ill and expired on 15th . Magh 1425 B.S. due to negligence and lack of treatment and care on the part of the accused persons . On the very fateful day the accused persons drove out the petitioner from their house after severe assault and asked her to go to her father`s house commit suicide there .

6----That again her father and one Santosh Gope reached the petitioner to her matrimonial home on 22nd . Chaitra 1425 B.S. but the accused persons did not allow her to enter the house . The accused persons threatened that they would give second marriage of accused Jukti Gope with another girl .

7----That your complainant reported the matter to the Officer in Charge Joypur Police station as well as the Superintendent of Police Purulia but of no good though the accused persons committed the offence punishable U/S 498A,323, ,506/34 I.P.C.& 3 & 4 D.P. Act .

8---That your complainant is a very poor woman . She is helpless having no source of in come whatsoever . She is not in a position to conduct the case on her own expense . Moreover , there are some technical and legal aspects involved in this case which also requires considerable money and machinery . For all these , it is highly desirable that this case should be converted to a police case for thorough Police investigation.

Pleased to direct the Officer In Charge Joypur Police Station to investigate the case in accordance with law , treating the same as F.I.R. , as contemplated U/S 156(3) Cr.P.C.
