Sir,
In producing here with 03(Three) arrested accused persons namely (1) Rahit Agarwal (30) S/O Nuresh Agarwal of village Manbazar Maity Road PS Manbazar District Purulia 2) Amit Banerjee (24) S/O Shibdas Banerjee of village Manbazar Hospital more PS Manbazar District Purulia 3) Narayan Mahato (21) S/O Kamal Mahato of village Nadiha PO- Gopalmagar,PS Manbazar District Purulia.

I beg to state that today (23.07.2020), I was directed to find out whether the lock down has been implanted properly at Manbazar Market area or not. This refers to Manbazar PS GDE No-1120, Dtd. 23.07.2020 . Accordingly, I had been to market area at about- 18:15 hrs I found that the above noted persons were roaming aimlessly at bazaar area. Myself along with force detained them at Manbazar Bank more more On Purulia -Boro road under Manbazar PS. On being asked the above accused persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 & 10/04/2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- II & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till now. Moreover all the detained persons were refuses to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. All the accused persons also tried negligently to spare infection of disease dangerous to life.

I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. Moreover they driven the motor cycle on public way in rash and negligently as to endanger to human life. On being asked they did not produce the valid documents in respect of said motor cycle as well as driving license.

All the process was done in between 19:35 hrs and 20:25 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested. As there was lock down in the town the peoples left the place and did not agreed to come forward to remain present.

I also refrained myself from encouraging much people to come out from home to remain present in the Police work in this time of Lock Down.
