In producing herewith the 02 persons namely (i) Khanku Rajwar (55 yrs) s/o Lt. Jethu Rajwar of vill- Mohada & (ii) Niranjan Gorain (23 yrs) S/O Ajit Gorain of vill- Raghabpur Rajakpara, both of PS-Purulia (M), Dist-Purulia before vou.

The fact of the case in a nut shell is that I ASI Kanchan Baran Gorain along with force namely 1) JC/614 Chiranjit Mandal 2) NVF/811 Banbehari Mahato was performing the Special Mobile duty for the implementation of Complete Lock Down in the area vide Purulia (M) PS GDE 959 dtd 23/07/2020 in consonance with C.C No 2041 Dtd. 23/07/2020 as per order of superior. During my Special Mobile Duty, while I arrived at Raghabpur Rajak Para at 17: 35 hrs and found two persons noted in the supra were loitering in the area without wearing any kind of Mask and asked them regarding the reason of their circumambulation on the road at the complete lock down day. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their circumambulation on road. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 283-CS/2020 dtd 21/07/2020. Subsequently it is pertinent to say that the supra noted persons did the negligent act knowing themselves that their malignant act were likely to spread infection of the epidemic diseases which is dangerous to life themselves and others. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the gourd of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo 283-CS/2020 dtd 21/07/2020 and did the negligent act knowing themselves that their malignant act were likely to spread infection of the epidemic diseases which is dangerous to life for themselves and others and their malignant act were likely to spread infection of the epidemic diseases which is dangerous to life of themselves and others so they can be booked U/S 188/269/270 of the IPC and 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act. 1897. So a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
