Sir,

I, SI Uttam Chatterjee S/O Late Dukhabhanjan Chatterjee of Pathakpara, P.S.& Dist. Bankura now posted at Santuri PS, Dist- Purulia produce (1) Manthu Dhibar (18 yrs) S/O- Ananda Dhibar (2) Chandra Dhibar (21yrs) S/O- Bablu Dhibar (3) Akash Dhibar (20yrs), S/O- Uttam Dhibar all of village Tarabari, PS- Santuri, Dist- Purulia (4) Biswanath Majee (50yrs) S/O- Khudiram Majee (5) Tilak Bauri (53yrs) S/O- Lt. Duburi Bauri both of village Santuri, PS- Santuri, Dist- Purulia and do hereby lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that today on 23.07.2020 the day of Lock down, while I along with C/330 Banamali Soren of Santuri PS as per direction engaged in special mobile duty within Santuri PS area, (Reference Santuri P.S G.D.E No.1110 dtd. 23.07.2020 and CC No- 2663/20 dated 23.07.2020) for implementation of Government rules regarding lockdown of Disaster Management Plan. While we proceeding towards Rambhattadhi More from Marbedia side under Santuri P.S jurisdiction and reached at Santuri Bazar through Raghunathpur- Saltora Road (SH-08) at about 18:45 hrs. found that the above noted 05(five) persons were gossiping at Santuri Bazar More without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining social distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were proceeding without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule. I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of arrest. Informed their family members through local people.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused (1) Manthu Dhibar (18 yrs) S/O- Ananda Dhibar (2) Chandra Dhibar (21yrs) S/O- Bablu Dhibar (3) Akash Dhibar (20yrs), S/O- Uttam Dhibar all of village Tarabari, PS- Santuri, Dist- Purulia (4) Biswanath Majee (50yrs) S/O- Khudiram Majee (5) Tilak Bauri (53) S/O- Lt. Duburi Bauri both of village Santuri, PS- Santuri, Dist- Purulia U/S- 188/34 IPC and 51 (b) Disaster Management Act, 2005 as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule and arrange for its investigation.
