Today (21.08.2020) myself SI Nagendra Nath Das along with force C/841 Chanchal Pramanik, C/458 Debendra Nath Mahato were engaged in Spl. mobile duty vide Spl. C.C NO- 282/2020, GDE No- 916 dt- 21.08.2020 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management plan. At about 15:05 Hrs, when myself along with force reached at Rangadih Railgate under Balarampur P.S. we found 04 (four) persons namely 1) Nepal Paramanik (27 yrs) S/O- Biswanath Paramanik of Vill- Shyamnagar, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Ajoy Sahis (21 yrs) S/O- Ankur Sahis of Vill- Chandanpur, Kharipahari, P.S- Barabazar, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Rathu Sahis (25 yrs) S/O- Makar Sahis of Vill- Chandanpur, Kharipahari, P.S- Barabazar, Dist.- Purulia, 4) Pijus Kaibartya (28 yrs) S/O- Rabindra Nath Kaibarta of Vill- Belyabadha, P.S- Barabazar, Dist.- Purulia without having mask were moving aimlessly without any reason. There is every chance to believe that the above noted 04 (four) persons came out from their home to making fun and halla at Rangadih Railgate, though lockdown is going on throughout all over West Bengal in view of Pandemic of COIVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 and 10/04/2020 and Memo No- 283-CS/2020 date-21.07.2020 and recent Memo No-287-CS/2020 Date-03.08.2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 272-CS/2020 dated 30.06.2020. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest guided by NHRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against 04 (four) persons namely 1) Nepal Paramanik (27 yrs) S/O- Biswanath Paramanik of Vill- Shyamnagar, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Ajoy Sahis (21 yrs) S/O- Ankur Sahis of Vill- Chandanpur, Kharipahari, P.S- Barabazar, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Rathu Sahis (25 yrs) S/O- Makar Sahis of Vill- Chandanpur, Kharipahari, P.S- Barabazar, Dist.- Purulia, 4) Pijus Kaibartya (28 yrs) S/O- Rabindra Nath Kaibarta of Vill- Belyabadha, P.S- Barabazar, Dist.- Purulia.
