I SI Kousik Banerjee (32 Years) S/O- Asit Banerjee, O/C Boro PS do hereby record this case as suomoto against Raimohon Murmu S/O- Jagat Chandra Murmu of Vill- Basantapur, P.S.- Boro Dist-Purulia and approx 50-60 unruly mob to the effect that today on 04.08.2020 at 10:45 hours. I received information from a passenger of a bus who did not disclosed his identity regarding road blockade at Basantapur More on Manbazar - Bandwan asphalt road via Basantapur (SH-05) under PS- Boro Dist- Purulia. I diarised the information at Boro PS GDE No. 107 at 10:45 hours. Accordingly myself along with SI Manas Dutta, C/297 Apurba Pandey, C/11 Ashim Roy, C/708 Mritunjoy Mura, C/401 Jagesh Mandi and C/313 Haripada Tudu and JLC/1145 Lakhimoni Mandi left PS for Basantapur More under PS Boro. After reaching there at about 11:05 hours. I found that the road at Basantapur More which runs between Manbazar and Bandwan via Basantapur had been blocked by 50-60 unruly mob leaded by Raimohon Murmu S/O- Jagat Chandra Murmu of Vill- Basantapur, P.S.- Boro Dist- Purulia, from 10:40 hours. They blocked the asphalt road over the issue of shifting some ration cards from RKSY-II to RKSY-I which will give them some extra facilities. Hence I talked with the people who had blocked the road and heard their complaints patiently and assured them that all legal steps will be taken to fulfill their demands along with the food and supply department, we also tried to convince them about the lock down situation regarding the COVID-19 that at present assembling of people in such a manner without maintaining social distancing and without wearing mask may be a threat to life as the pandemic COVID-19 is spreading rapidly but they did not pay any heed to my request. I also tried to pacify them several times but they did not pay any heed to my request and continued road blocking till 16.00 hours causing in convenience to several passengers and people who were in the on-route busses and vehicles. It was also found that more then 30/35 different types of vehicles loaded with passengers and goods and drivers including patients, minor baby etc. from Boro side and Manbazar side were detained there from 10:40 hrs and subjected to enormous sufferings for a long time. When the people assembling there turned in riotous mood and enhance their agitation vocally to a great extant the entire ambience on the road become very violent, having no other alternative way I declared the mob as unlawful assembly and commanded them to disperse accordingly but the unruly mob continued to be with the unlawful assembly, causing unlawful restraint to the vehicles and passersby and thus generated danger and obstruction in public way. Meanwhile CI Manbazar and SDPO Manbazar with reinforcement and also BDO Manbazar-II, and SCFS, Manbazar arrived at the spot and after prolonged discussion with the agitators, the agitators lastly withdrew the road blockade at 16:00 hrs and thereafter vehicular traffic became normal. As the unruly mob was huge in number, so immediate arrest of the unruly mob could not be affected and no lathi charge could be resorted as there was a chance of serious law & order problem. On returning to Boro PS I recorded Boro PS Case No- 43/2020 dated- 04.08.2020 U/S 143 /145 /283 /341/ 506 /188/ 269/ 270/109/114 IPC, Read with sec.18 of the west Bengal Highway Act. -1964 and sec. 51 of disaster management Act. 2005 against Raimohon Murmu S/O- Jagat Chandra Murmu of Vill-Basantapur, P.S.- Boro Dist- Purulia and approx 50-60 unruly mob and directed SI Muktipada Ghosh to take up investigation of the case.
