I, SI Partha Kumar Bhunia, O/C Manbazar PS do hereby lodge this FIR as suomoto against (1) Soumitra @ Rana Banerjee, S/O- Nandagopal Banerjee, 2) Ashis Bauri S/O Naru Bauri, 3) Karuna Bauri S/o Ananda Bauri, 4) Prakash Bauri S/O Sudeb Bauri, 5) Rabi Bauri S/O Taran Bauri and all of village- Gopalnagar, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia to the effect that today (06.08.20) at around 13.05 hrs received a telephonic information that some person of Gopalnagar village had blocked Manbazar Purulia Road (SH-5) near Gopalnagar bus stand more without any prior information or permission and a huge numbers of vehicles including Public buses got obstructed. The matter is noted in G.D vide Manbazar PS G.D.E No-200, dtd-06/08/20. Accordingly myself along with ASI Subhendu Mahato and force rushed to the spots and found that a large numbers of vehicles were obstructed in a queue and approx 50 persons had blocked the road by placing cycles, motorcycles and they were sitting on the road. The mob was unruly. I tried to convince them but they were reluctant and obstinate to hear me. I asked them to disperse in loud and clear voice but they did not pay any heed to my word. I declared them as unlawful assembly but they did not care a fig. But in compare to the mob we were insufficient in number to overpower them. So there was no option but to wait. We started waiting and trying to convince them to clear the road for the interest of common people but all our endeavor went in air. They willfully was doing this blockage with intent to injuriously affect the State Highway (SH-5) causing extreme inconvenience to common people violating our order without having any order either from any concerned authority. hrs. Hence I talked with the people who had blocked the road and heard their complaints patiently and assured them that all legal steps will be taken to fulfill their demands. we also tried to convince them about the lock down situation regarding the COVID-19 that at present assembling of people in such a manner without maintaining social distancing and without wearing mask may be a threat to life as the pandemic COVID-19 is spreading rapidly but they did not pay any heed to my request. I also tried to pacify them several times but they did not pay any heed to my request and continued road blocking till 14.00 hours causing inconvenience to several passengers and people who were in the on-route busses and vehicles. It was also found that more then 30/35 different types of vehicles loaded with passengers and goods and drivers including patients, minor baby etc. Manbazar side were detained there from 13.00 hrs and subjected to enormous sufferings for a long time. When the people assembling there turned in riotous mood and enhance their agitation vocally to a great extent the entire ambience on the road become very violent, having no other alternative way I declared the mob as unlawful assembly and commanded them to disperse accordingly but the unruly mob continued to be with the unlawful assembly, causing unlawful restraint to the vehicles and passersby and thus generated danger and obstruction in public way. after prolonged discussion with the agitators, the agitators lastly withdrew the road blockade at 14.00 hrs and thereafter vehicular traffic became normal. As the unruly mob was huge in number. so immediate arrest of the unruly mob could not be effected and no lathi charge could be resorted as there was a chance of serious law & order problem.

Hence I do record Manbazar PS Case No-77/20 dtd -06/08/2020, U/S-143/188/269/270/34 IPC and Sec 18 of the west Bengal Highway Act. -1964 and sec. 51 of disaster management Act. 2005 as suomoto against (1) Soumitra @ Rana Banerjee, S/O- Nandagopal Banerjee, 2) Ashis Bauri S/O Naru Bauri, 3) Karuna Bauri S/o Ananda Bauri, 4) Prakash Bauri S/O Sudeb Bauri, 5) Rabi Bauri S/O Taran Bauri and all of village- Gopalnagar, PS- Manbazar, Dist- Purulia approx 50 peoples of Gopalnagar village and directed SI Soumen Kumar Panda to investigate the case.
