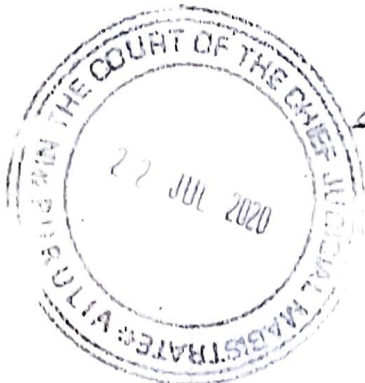

It should be mentioned here for lively food of the complainant, he often have to go out of station for the purpose of earning in different brick-cillina

5) That the complainant often heard from different person and relation of his village about the wife extra marital relationship of his wife with said Banamali paul but as deep trust upon the wife of complainant, so he did not pay any heed to such blans thrown by villagers against his wife.

6) That thus when the complainant was out of station for his work on 2nd Ashar 1427 B.S. corresponding to 17/6/2020 at about 2.00 p.m. it was noticed by above named witnesses that at the relevant date and time, they found said Banamali paul to abused the wife of the complainant in loud voice and was uttering slang languages

saying " *Handwritten Odia text: ମାମୁଲି ତୋର ମନିକର ଦେଖାକିମ୍ପା ଏବଂ ତୋର ସ୍ତ୍ରୀର ନି ସାଙ୍ଗରେ ସୁମାର୍ଗେ ଏକାନ୍ତେ ମାତ୍ରୋ ମରାଜାମ ଦାସିମା, ମିତ୍ର ମରାଜା (ତୋର ଯତ୍ରି) ବନ୍ଦା ହୋଇଅଛୁ* "

6) That on 20/06/2020 when the complainant returned to his village some villagers namely Bhajan Kumbhakar, Meghnath Kumbhakar, Dhiren Kumbhakar and others informed the complainant about the said incident of dated 17/6/2020 but the complainant also out of deep love and affection

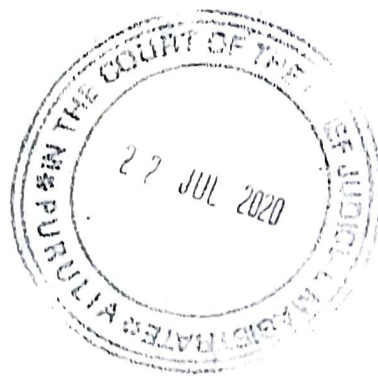

to his wife ignored the said information, given to him by the person's named above.

8) That the complainant on this occasion during his stay at his house noticed that his wife seemd to be highly depressed and out of shame, she started keeping her self confined in house and also noticed that she often used to avoid to take adequate meal, and also retrained her self from talking with any other person's of the village.

9) That on 03/07/2020 at about 7.30 p.m. when the complainant was out of his house for working nearby village and his wife was coming back after responding nature call, she was obstructed by said Banamali paul and without giving her any oportunity to ask about such reason of obstructing her and said Banamali Paul all on a sudden poured kerosin oil on her body and set her on fire and when she raised " alarm Bancha-Pancho" some villagers namely Swapan Kumbhakar, Goutam Kumbhakar, Dhiren Kumbhakar and Meghnath Kumbhakar rushed to the place and seeing then Banamali Paul fledaway by assuring said villagers that he is going to bring a vehicle to shift her for treatment to hospital.

11) That the above named villagers informed the complainant who immediately rushed to the village and took appropriate step and shifted her to Purulia Sadar Hospital for treatment but in vain. The complainant believe that here but the accused named above has committed the crime.

12) That incident was duly informed to the Purulia (M) P. S. by the complainant and witnesses but police personal of Purulia (M), P.S. did not take any step against the miscreant, there after the complainant informed the matter to S.P. Purulia but off no good.

13) That the investigation of the matter involves number of seizer of relevent documents, P.M. report, inquest report and as well as examination the require 2 witnesses which will not possible by the complainant as his own cost and hence this complaint.
