Sir,


I, SI Biswarup Roy, S/O Shri Jitendra Nath Roy of Bahadurpur P.S-Jamuraia, Dist- Paschim Bardhaman do hereby produced (1) Shiblal Kisku (23yrs) S/O- Lt. Chandrakanta Kisku of Jiyalgoria, PS- Kashipur, Dist- Purulia (2) Sunil Saren (35 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ganesh Saren of Lankabaid, PS-Kashipur, Dist. Purulia, (3) Tapan Sarkar (37 yrs) S/O-Santi Sarkar of Kalipahari, PS-Santuri, Dist-Purulia do hereby lodge a written complaint against them to the effect that today on 25.08.2020 while I along with C/233 Upananda Das & C/99 Shambhunath Dutta of Santuri PS as per direction engaged in special mobile duty within Santuri PS area, (Reference Santuri P.S G.D.E No. 1024 dtd. 25.08.2020 vide C.C. No. 3128/20 dtd. 25.08.2020) for implementation of Government rules regarding Disaster Management Plan. While we were returning from Rambhattadi side under Santuri P.S jurisdiction and reached at Ledason Morh through Raghunathpur – Saltora road (SH-8) at 18:05 hrs. found that the above noted 03 (three) persons, were gossiping without maintaining norms of COVID-19 as well as without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining social distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule. So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of arrest and informed their family members through local people.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused (1) Shiblal Kisku (23yrs) S/O- Lt. Chandrakanta Kisku of Jiyalgoria, PS- Kashipur, Dist- Purulia (2) Sunil Saren (35 yrs) S/O- Lt. Ganesh Saren of Lankabaid, PS-Kashipur, Dist. Purulia, (3) Tapan Sarkar (37 yrs) S/O-Santi Sarkar of Kalipahari, PS-Santuri, Dist-Purulia under proper section of law as they disobeyed/ignored Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule and arrange for its investigation.
