Today (27.08.2020) myself S.I Satrugna Mahato along with force were on regular mobile-duty vide Spl. C.C NO- 314/2020, GDI No- 1455 dt- 31.08.2020 and as per direction I was engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding Lockdown and disaster management vide order dt- 23.08.20, when myself along with force reached at Balarampur Chowk Bazar trade fair ground around 03 (three) persons namely 1) Motilal Mahato (55 yrs) S/O- Lt. Bhonath Mahato of Vill- Harra, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Hiralal Karmakar (28 yrs) S/O- Lt. Santosh Karmakar of Vill- Karma, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Khagen Mahato (47 yrs) S/O- Akhay Mahato of Vill- Bela, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia without having mask were moving aimlessly without any reason. I have every chance to believe that the above noted 03 (three) persons came out from their home to go to shop and halla at Balarampur Chowk Bazar, though lockdown is going on throughout all over the country in view of Pandemic of COIVD-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No- 272-MS-1(A) Date- 24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 04/04/2020, 07/04/2020 and Memo No- 283-CS/2020 date-21.07.2020 and recent Memo No-287 CS/2020 dated-22.08.2020 for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this critical situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 272-CS/2020 dated-24.03.2020 therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of COVID-19, dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest procedure as per IRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be registered against 03 (three) persons namely 1) Motilal Mahato (55 yrs) S/O- Lt. Bhonath Mahato of Vill- Harra, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 2) Hiralal Karmakar (28 yrs) S/O- Lt. Santosh Karmakar of Vill- Karma, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia, 3) Khagen Mahato (47 yrs) S/O- Akhay Mahato of Vill- Bela, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia.
