Sir,

In producing here with one tractor attached with trolley bearing Registration No- WB-55A/1893(tractor number) loaded with sand about 100 CFT(aaprox), Seizure list, Alamat and sample of Alamat as exhibit A; I beg to state that today on 13/09/2020 myself along with C/1147 Bappaditya Nandi and C/975 Ashok Saharoy performing special mobile duty vide CC No-2942/2020 dt 13/09/2020 and GDE No-658 and GD entry no 667 (at 13.25 hrs) dt 13/09/2020 with Govt vehicle bearing Registration No- WB 24 C 0788. I was carrying normal investigation kit box with me and electronic gazettes.

As per information I reached at Biskudra more at about 13.55 hrs. Got further information from source about extracting and transportation of sand with intend to sale to other destinations by illegal means from Kumari river sides and going towards Barabazar/Purulia under this dist jurisdiction.

I conveyed the same to I.C Barabazar again and as per his direction I along with force started Naka checking at Biskudra mor from 14.05 hrs. At about 14.25 hrs one tractor having registration No- WB-55A/1893 loaded with sand was coming toward the Naka point and seeing the police party the driver fled away after keeping the tractor beside the Sindri Barabazar road at Biskudra. Chased him but somehow he managed to escape. Seized the tractor (WB-55A/1893) attached with trolley loaded with sand about 100 Cft approx.

Held an enquiry about the matter and so far information collected it is crystal clear that the driver and the owner of the vehicle collected the sand by illegal means with intend to make unlawful profit by unlawful collection of sand through illegal manner by unauthorized extraction and removal of mines & minerals. By this way they committed theft of minor minerals. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said Tractor with ill motive were transporting the sand illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand & violated the Lockdown order. They violated the Govt. order of not extracting sand from river. As such they were doing illegal business activities.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I pray before you that kindly take needful action against the driver of the tractor and owner of the tractor.
