Sir,

In producing herewith the accused namely Ukil Mahato (25 yrs) S/o-Bhagirath Mahato of Vill-Padudih, PS-Pindrajora, Dist-Bokaro (JKD) along with seized Tractor (Engine) along with trolley having Regd No-JH09AB-0522 with loaded sand under proper seizure list. The fact of the case in brief is that on 13/09/2020, I along with force (1) C/-237 Gopinath Roy (2) C/-120 Sandip Kumar (3) C/-195 Santosh Singh Sardar all of Joypur P.S were on Day Mobile duty vide Joypur PS CC No-3602/20 date-13/09/2020. During mobile duty on 13/09/2020 at about 14:15 hrs under direct Supervision of IC Joypur PS conducted raid at Chitahi on the Bank of River Kansai and found that the above noted Tractor was present at Chitahi on the Bank River of Kansai loaded with sand. On seeing the Police party the driver of the said Tractor stopped his Tractor at Kansai river and tried to fled away but we manage to apprehended him and the Tractor detained at 14:15 hrs. I also asked the driver to produce valid papers in respect of sand and vehicle but he failed produce any papers. Hence I seized the Tractor (Engine) along with trolley having Regd. No- JH09AB-0522 loaded with sand under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses, duly signed by the witnesses and the accused driver. I brought the said Tractor to Joypur P.S. The said driver and owner are habitually dealing with illegal sand lifting & transporting business violating the Govt. Notification / Order. As such there is very reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said Tractor are lifting & transporting the sand from riverbed with ill motive and illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand and also violating the order notification vide DM Purulia Memo No-VI/430(Part-VIII)/1176/M/90/M/17 Dated-26/06/2020. Regarding ban of sand lifting from riverbed.

Hence they are liable for offence punishable U/S- 188/379/411/414 IPC & 21 (1) (4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.

Therefore, I pray before you that a case against the driver and owner of the said Tractor may kindly be started and arrange for its investigation.
